

God's Intervention in Students' Lives

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Introduction

Parents can become overwhelmed when God presents them with a new human life. An infant is totally helpless. Infants cannot speak and cannot communicate with their parents. Infants cannot perform any of the normal functions of daily living after God works with his or her parents to bring him or her into the world.

However, God has an individual relationship with all our infants and toddlers. God has an individual relationship with all the parents of newborn children and toddlers. God perfectly understands all the issues that the parents of an infant and a toddler will face after childbirth.

God exploits His individual relationship with infants to work with them to begin to develop them into toddlers. God works with parents to have patience while He works with them and with the infant to get them to a point where they can all communicate with each other.

God helps parents to teach our infants how to talk and how to love their parents, their siblings, and their loved ones. God exploits His individual relationship with infants to help them to show love for the infant's loved ones.

God works in mysterious ways to intervene in the lives and in the development of not only our infants but in the lives of all our toddlers and our children. Parents feel the love of God in their lives. Parents feel the love of God in the way that their infants and toddlers show love for them. Parents find God through their relationships with their infants, toddlers, and children.

God allows parents to hear a young infant's thoughts. Parents must understand how their infant feels about how he or she is being treated. An infant need to convey his or her feelings about the way that he or she loves his or her parents through the way that God allows parents to hear an infant's thoughts.

God's love between an infant, parents, and loved ones work together to work to develop an infant into a toddler. That same love helps God to develop a toddler into a child. God wants to build His personal relationship with a child when He is working to develop an infant into a toddler. God works in the background to show love for the parents of a child even if the child cannot immediately talk.

God builds an attachment with all His infants, toddlers, and children. God wants to show His children how much He loves all of them. God wants them to understand the happiness that they bring to Him, to their loved ones, and to Humanity.

God wants parents to develop children properly. Parents must work with God to develop children properly so that they can understand the difference between right and wrong without feeling pain and suffering. God has special ways of disciplining his toddlers and children so that they will know what they have done wrong and that they cannot do wrong again without feeling pain.

Understanding a baby's thoughts is like understanding the thoughts of a toddler or of a child. Some parents and educators have problems understanding the true feelings of our toddlers and children during periods of crisis and during periods of peace and tranquility. We must do everything that we can to completely understand the way that our infants, toddlers, and children understand reality. We must understand when we need to ask God to help us by intervening in a child's life to help them.

The Early Years – Toddlers

Teaching Toddlers to Speak

God has a personal relationship with all toddlers. God loves His toddlers. God's toddlers mean the world to Him. God wants to intervene in the lives of His toddlers to make it easier for parents and siblings to continue to develop toddlers properly. God helps parents, siblings, and loved one to understand a toddler's needs so that they can properly show love for the toddler.

God's personal relationship with a toddler helps him or her to learn how to speak. There comes a time when parents stop hearing a baby's thoughts or a toddler's thoughts. There comes a time when God will challenge a toddler to talk to his or her parents and loved ones. God helps toddlers to develop the capability to understand the spoken language. God helps toddlers to convey their thoughts about their issues by struggling to talk to their parents and loved ones.

Toddlers automatically achieve an Attachment to God which helps them to show love for others by helping them to speak to adults and to siblings. God wants toddlers to feel happiness and joy throughout the toddler years. God wants a toddler's family to bring happiness and joy to their toddler. God wants a toddler's love for his or her family to bring joy for his parents, siblings, and family members.

God has a way of intervening in the lives of our infants and toddlers that helps them to mature properly so that God helps them to understand that they have an obligation to show love for others and to bring joy and happiness to all their parents and loved ones. Toddlers must understand God when He requires them to show love and affection for God and for their parents, siblings, and everyone else that loves them very much.

Hearing an Infant's Thoughts

It is hard to completely understand what an infant or toddler is trying to say to a parent, guardian, or family member. Parents can feel devastation when they cannot completely understand the needs of their infant or toddler.

God has an individual relationship with the father and the mother of the infant and/or toddler. God talks to a father and to a mother. God needs to intervene in the way that parents deal with their babies and toddlers. God does not want parents to run out of options in the way that they deal with their babies and toddlers.

God has a way of interpreting the thoughts and the needs of babies and toddlers. God is the master that understands the issues of infants and toddlers. God intervenes in a crisis when parents have no way to understand how to how to satisfy the needs of a child.

Parents work with God to hear and to understand the thoughts of a baby and/or a toddler. God helps parents to understand what has gone wrong with their baby and/or toddler. God helps parents to understand what to do to correct the problem. God guides the parents to do what they must do to correct the problem.

God also allows parents to hear a baby and/or a toddlers' thoughts of love when a baby does not know how to show affection and love for his or her parents as an infant or toddler.

Teaching Social Skills

It is so important to teach our toddlers to be sociable with others. Parents must work with God to teach toddlers to develop the capability to form social relationships with family members and with other toddlers in daycare programs, Kindergarten, and in the early grades in grammar schools.

God uses His individual relationship with either a male toddler or a female partner to help them to understand how to build social relationships. God wants our toddlers and children to be able to form friendships. God wants them to be able to play with other children of their same age group. God wants them to be able to function as part of peer groups in their daycare programs and in their early years in their grammar schools.

God wants to work with parents to help kids to understand how to teach toddlers and kids to be able to have a conversation with someone that they have just met. God wants to help our toddlers and children to understand what fellow students say to them both in school and in other situation outside of school.

God wants toddlers and children to understand the importance of being able to form social relationships. God wants our toddlers and children to understand the benefits of developing friendships and social relationships at a very young age. God can use His personal relationship with our students to coach them if they struggle to understand how to understand basic concepts in how to love and to form friendships with other peers both in school and outside of school.

Parents and siblings must try to help our toddlers and children to be able to be sociable. Our families must try hard to help our toddlers and children to function within peer groups. Functioning in peer groups at an early age will help our toddlers and kids to find God and their destiny at a later age.

Mild Discipline for Children

Most toddlers and children do not know the difference between right and wrong. Our children make mistakes all the time. Some of our children think that they can do anything that they want to do without the permission of their parents or of their guardians.

We must find ways to discipline toddlers and children while not making them to feel pain and suffering. Discipline that hurts children hurts God. God does not tolerate any type of discipline that causes physical and/or emotional injury upon children. God wants to work with parents and guardians to be peaceful when we identify that something that a child has done is wrong and that a child should not continue doing what the child has been doing wrong.

God must intervene in an educator's efforts to discipline a child. It is very easy for an educator to cause a student to have a nervous breakdown if he or she tries to embarrass the child and to embarrass the child in front of his or her classmates. God does not want to see that in our classrooms.

God must intervene in any efforts to help children to understand that they have done something wrong. God must intervene when educators and parents need to help a child that he or she cannot continue to keep making the same mistake. Parents and educators must be very forgiving of a child that makes mistakes in school because he or she does not know any better than to behave in a way that is inappropriate. We should reward children after discipline has succeeded to solve their problems.

Understanding Right and Wrong

It is important for parents and educators to begin to teach our children the difference between right and wrong when they are children because it will be easier for children to avoid serious problem as children and young adults. How do parents and educators work with God to teach children the difference between right and wrong?

Religious school students understand the difference between right and wrong somewhat because they understand the Ten Commandments and the teachings of Judaism and Christianity. Maybe children that study religious doctrine will be better able to understand the difference between right and wrong.

Students in public schools sometimes do not receive any training in understanding the difference between right and wrong. Sometimes our public-school students have no religious training. Sometimes they have no criminal-justice training. They do not understand just how serious their mistakes can be until they must face the discipline of a suspension or of an expulsion. Where do our public-school students learn about the difference between right and wrong? Where do all our students learn about the criminal justice system?

Every toddler and child must rely on his or her individual relationship with God to make decisions that would be reasonable. God does not tell our toddlers and young adults to misbehave. God does not coach them to do things that will get them into trouble. God's goal with toddlers and children is to do everything that He can to keep His toddlers and children out of trouble.

God wants to guide our toddlers and children to behave themselves so that it will be easier for Him to keep them out of more serious trouble in the future. That is part of the way that God intervenes in the lives of our toddlers and children.

Dealing with a Crying Toddler/Child

There are so many reasons why a toddler or a child will cry. A toddler may be in pain because he or she cannot release gas. Too much gas in the intestines can cause them to feel pain and that can cause them to cry. Sometimes they will be in the process of potty-training and will panic when he or she must go to the bathroom.

There are times when a toddler would want a parent to buy him or her a certain toy and the parent would have to say no. Maybe the parent would not have the money to pay for it. There might be another reason for a parent's refusal to buy a toddler a toy.

God helps parents and educators to understand why a toddler or a child starts to cry. It is obvious that a toddler or child is in physical or emotional pain if they are crying. God helps educators and parents to identify what is causing pain for a toddler or what is causing pain for a child.

God works with parents to try to end a crying episode in a toddler or a child by showing love and affection for that child. God does not want our toddlers and children to cry in response to emotional or physical pain under any circumstances. God wants our parents and educators to make sure that they can care for our students to treat the problem that makes them cry. Parents and educators can try to get the toddler or child to function after whatever went wrong with him or her.

God, Reading, Writing, and Math

God helps educators to teach Kindergarten, first grade, and second grade students to understand how to read, to count, and to write. Each of our children in the first grade have a personal relationship with God that helps them to understand how to interpret how to read words and sentences for the first time. God teaches our first-grade and second-grade students how to count and how to perform basic arithmetic processes.

Educators in the lower grades of Kindergarten, the first grade, and the second grade do not fully understand that they all answer to God. God works with them to develop the skills and the social capabilities of their students. God shows love for young students through the love that a teacher has for his or her students. Students reward God and their educators by trying to study and to succeed in their courses. Students show love for their educators and for God by doing everything that they can to do the best job that they can do in their courses.

It is amazing that educators in public schools, private schools, and religious schools do not understand that it is the intervention of God that helps them to develop the academic capabilities and the social functioning of their students. God is a Supreme Being that is responsible for the development of all human life. God is especially involved in working with parents, educators, and students to help them to make sure that lower-grade students have the best possible chance to succeed when they are promoted into the higher grades.

Our students can look to God's intervention to help them to understand their concepts in their classes and to maximize their chances of achieving success in the higher grades of grammar schools, high schools, and colleges.

God Intervenes in Behavior Training

God works with parents and educators to teach our toddlers and children to learn proper methods of behavior both in school and outside of school.

God works with parents and siblings to help toddlers and children to develop a good attitude toward fellow students, family members, and educators. Parents want toddlers and children to have a loving response to any non-family member that tries to show love and affection for him or her. God wants toddlers and children to show happiness for anyone that meets any of them and experiences the Love of God when they see the toddler or the child.

God and parents must teach toddlers and children to never have a bad attitude toward others that might give them an impression that they have a bad attitude. Parents should teach children to never give any child or adult a hurtful attitude or a hurtful rejection.

God and parents want to teach our toddlers and children the correct way for a toddler or a child to greet a stranger. Toddlers and children should learn how to have a sociable attitude toward their family's friends and acquaintances. Toddlers and children should learn how to show affection for friends of the family.

Toddlers should learn how to understand how to tolerate conflict and how to work with God to resolve conflict with another toddler and/or child in the lower grades of grammar school and daycare.

The Holy Spirit Intervenes Also

The Holy Spirit is an Entity of Higher Intelligence that supervises all schools and all educators in the world. The Holy Spirit works with God to identify problems with our schools and to try to solve those problems by spiritual intervention.

The Holy Spirit does not want God to punish a school where students might not be doing as well as God would want them to be performing. The Holy Spirit does not want anyone to try to punish our educators when something seems to have gone in our schools. The Holy Spirit gets involved when God tends to lose His patience with our schools.

The Holy Spirit works in the background in public schools, private schools, and religious schools to help educators to fix problems that exist in their schools. The Holy Spirit wants to guide our teacher and our students to attempt to improve whatever problems seem to exist in the school.

God can become very upset when He discovers a serious problem in a school. The Holy Spirit becomes involved when a school needs help. All schools need help at one time or another. Schools do not need severe punishment from God on top of the life-threatening problems that already exist within them.

The Holy Spirit can train and guide teachers through any crisis that might threaten the emotional and physical wellbeing of our students. The Holy Spirit can reach out to help our students through the love that the government and law enforcement officials have for them. The Holy Spirit wants to get government officials involved to try to fix problems in a school.

God and the Holy Spirit work together to help to fix what is wrong with our schools and to guide our schools to produce successful students and to produce successful graduates.

Kids Do Not Always Detect God

Toddlers and children do not always detect the presence of God and of the Holy Spirit in their lives. Some of these kids do not pray. Some of these kids do not think about God at all. Some of these kids have no idea about what God does for all of us in our lives.

God tries to help all of us whether we think about Him or do not think about Him. God tries to love all students that do not recognize that He exists. God tries to save the lives of those students that have achieved a detachment from God.

It is very difficult for God to help people that do not show love for Him at all. God is very hurt when our brothers and sisters all over the world ignore God. God is hurt by the offensive sexual behaviors that he witnesses all over the world.

God loves our kids. God tries to do everything that is in His Power to reach our kids and to develop them into productive adults and parents

However, God finds it more and more difficult to save the lives of those that think that they can exist without any involvement of God in their lives. We all answer to God. We all depend on God for our survival. We must all understand that God must be a part of everything that we do. Detaching ourselves from God can only lead to incarceration, illness, homelessness, unemployment, and death.

Teaching Children about God

Toddlers and Kids Need to Pray

Parents have an obligation to teach their toddlers and young children to begin the process of teaching them to communicate with God through prayer.

Encouraging our toddlers and children to pray to God daily can elevate their level of functioning and can make them more successful in their day care programs and in their grammar school. Teaching our kids to follow God's guidance through prayer can make their lives happier and more successful. Our kids can become more sociable. Our kids could get higher grades in school. Our kids could be more successful in their coursework in the classes.

Kids that do not pray can also enjoy a relationship with God. However, the student's parents and educators can encourage the student to do anything that he or she wants without the authorization of God. These students would reject God's efforts to help them because they would not want to understand that God exists and that God should be part of mostly everything that we do in our lives.

We must teach our kids to pray so that they will understand that God has a major role to play in all our lives. Our kids cannot just do anything that they want to do. They must understand that they answer to their parents and to God. They must get approval from God and from their parents to pursue any activities or accomplishments that they want to pursue.

We must teach our kids to recognize the existence of God in their lives. We must teach them how to talk to God daily. We must help them to understand the benefits of talking to God every day through prayer.

We must help them to understand that they always have the freedom to reach out to God for guidance and help when we need to get help from a Supreme Being. God is always there to help kids that recognize that God exists in their lives and that care about them.

Benefits of Prayer

God and the Holy Spirit can help our kids and young adults to make the right decisions about so many different issues that devastate young adults currently.

God can give very powerful assistance and guidance to those kids and young adults that feel comfortable in praying to Him and that are willing to have a conversation with Him. God can help to guide our kids and young adults to their goals through prayer and mutual communication.

Prayer can keep our kids and young adults out of trouble. God can stop our children and young adults from smoking, drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, and/or using weapons. God can guide kids away from these problems to save their lives when they pray to Him and when they are willing to do what He wants them to do.

Prayer helps our kids and young adults to respect the will of God. We must understand that the Will of God is the best course of action that our kids and young adults can agree to follow. Kid and young adults qualify for major rewards when they pray and have conversations with God.

The Roles of God's Love

God wants our kids and young adults that He protects them from self-inflicted harm. God prevents others from hurting our kids and young adults. God tries hard to stop our children and young adults from inflicting harm upon others. God tries to keep our kids and young adults from breaking the rules and from breaking the laws.

God wants to protect our kids and young adults from drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, from smoking tobacco, and from using firearms. God tries to stop our kids from hurting themselves by using these substances and a device, a gun, that can cause you to lose your freedom for the rest of your life if you should choose to use it.

God's Love helps students to honor their parents. God's Love helps our students to pursue good grades in school. God's Love helps to encourage kids and young adults to show love for their fellow students and to their educators by trying hard to get good grades in school.

Kids and young adults that experience God's Love can understand how to have a loving premarital relationship with a partner of the opposite gender. The love that the young adult man and the young adult woman would have for each other would come from God. God would share His love for them so that they could consider a life of marriage and parenthood together.

God's Love helps us to be excellent students. God's Love helps us to find happiness in our relationships. God's love helps us to work to prepare for a career and for parenthood. God's Love for us helps us to fulfill the responsibilities of a career and of parenthood. God's Love will lead us to everlasting peace and happiness. That is what we need to teach to our children and young adults.

God Rewards Kids and Young Adults

What happens when our kids and young adult honor God by getting good grades and for praying to him every day so that God can help him or her with his or her issues? God gets emotional when He finds children and young adults that trust His Judgment. God loves to feel the love of kids and young adults when they ask Him for help through prayer and through simple conversation with Him.

There are many rewards that await our kids and young adults for honoring God for recognizing His existence in our lives and for going to Him for guidance and support through prayer.

Students can succeed in getting excellent grades in school. Students can grasp all the skills, ideas, concepts, course objectives that they would need to complete to do very well in school.

Students would be guided away from any other adults or young adults that might try to hurt them with drugs or alcohol. God would try to make sure that His loving kids and young adults would never become substance abusers.

God can present our young adults with the marital partner of their dreams. That can bring much happiness to God, to the man in the relationship, and to the woman in the relationship. They can dream about an engagement, a marriage, a career, and parenthood.

God and the Holy Spirit want to help those of us with mental illness. God wants our brothers and sisters to pray every day and to try to reach Him so that He can help them to function.

The Holy Spirit Watches Over Us

The Holy Spirit loves our kids and young adults. The Holy Spirit works with God to help our kids to make the right decisions about their lives. The Holy Spirit helps God to be patient and understanding when our kids and young adults need extra help and extra counseling to behave normally.

The Holy Spirit sometimes must hurt certain people that threaten them with substance abuse and violence. The Holy Spirit has not patience with anyone that wants to hurt our kids and young adults with drugs or violence.

The Holy Spirit tries hard to discipline kids and young adults in a silent tone of voice inside their minds. The Holy Spirit kindly tells them to stop offending God and their community with their behaviors before they will face the punishment of God and of their community. The Holy Spirit tries to understand what our kids and young adults are doing wrong before it gives them their final warnings.

The Holy Spirit also helps kids and young adults from discipline from educators and from their parents. The Holy Spirit tries to help the kids and young adults to understand what they had done wrong. This is a plain explanation. The Holy Spirit then gives students final warnings about being a repeat offender. The Holy Spirit hopes that the students that have broken the rules can escape God's anger, the anger of the school, and the anger of the community.

God and the Holy Spirit try hard to stop their kids and young adults from committing crimes as juveniles. God and the Holy Spirit feel the ultimate pain when a student loses his or her freedom in juvenile detention or when a student faces a suspension or an expulsion from a school.

Students that know that they must communicate with God daily can avoid the catastrophic punishment that other students, that are detached from God, would face.

God and Religious Training

All our kids should study about God. Some students receive religious training in our schools. Then there are some students that do not receive religious training at all. Some students pray daily while others do not pray at all.

We all have an obligation to God to recognize that He exists. We must pursue a program that would allow us to study and to learn about God through religious education. It is not fair that public

school students do not receive any religious training in their schools. It is not fair that many of the do not receive religious training outside of school. This causes a detachment from God that can seriously injure a student's life.

Religions exist because we all have an obligation to God to learn about Him by studying the doctrines of His Prophets. Our kids and young adults cannot walk around without a relationship with God. That was a problem for the prophets thousands of years ago. Unfortunately, it is a problem now. Our kids and young adults must understand that everyone, all over the world, answers to God, to the One True God of the Jews. We are not going to solve our problems until we understand that God must be part of the solutions to our problems.

We are obligated to encourage all our kids and young adults to pursue an investigation of God by pursuing and studying a religion while they are either in a public school or in a religious school.

Training Students to Love Others

We can show love for others because of the love that God has shown for us in our lives. We must help our kids and young adults to understand the Love that God has for them. We must try to understand how to train our kids to understand and to detect the love that God has for them.

The love that we have for others comes from God. God helps us to realize that there are many ways to show love and affection for others. God wants our kids and young adults to show love for fellow students. God wants to promote social behaviors between kids and young adults in our schools. God wants our schools to be free of conflict and hatred. God wants all students in all our schools to understand that all students are obliged to love Him.

God trains us to love others. God trains us to love others through our parents, through our educators, through our religious leaders, and through our peers. God wants us to receive the training to love others to come from many different people. God wants us to be able to develop the ability to love as is humanly possible.

God trains kids and young adults to love others in our schools to develop us into adults that can love a spouse of the opposite gender and that can love sons and daughters. God only wants love to exist between ourselves in our lives. God does not want to tolerate hatred and conflict with anyone that our students must encounter in their lives.

Parents are the first persons to teach kids and young adults to experience the Love of God. Kids and young adults then get help from God to be able to share the love that God has for them with others in their lives.

What Is the Power of Prayer?

Prayer is someone's effort to communicate with our Supreme Being. This is a Being that is responsible for maintaining the existence of all life. One of God's objective in His life is to resolve all the conflict that exists within Humanity.

Prayer allows God to penetrate our lives so that God can get involved in making decisions about how to resolve a conflict that exists in a person's life. Prayer gives God the authorization to give us the power to do what we must do to resolve any life-threatening conflict that exists in our lives.

Prayer releases anyone that tries to hurt us from our lives. No one can hurt us once we seek help from God through prayer. God will not allow that.

God will help us to understand how to deal with a situation when we must deal with someone that is committing a crime against us. God is the One Being that can guide us to prosecute whoever is trying to hurt us. God cannot allow anyone to continue to commit crimes against us if we pray to Him for help because the commission of those crimes exist in our lives.

Prayer is very powerful in a kid's life and in a young adult's life because it helps students to exist in a social academic existence without conflict and without feeling the justification to need to hurt fellow students and others outside of school. Prayer is very powerful because God helps us to be good students and to enable us to achieve nothing but success on our exams and on our assignments so that we can be prepared for promotions and graduations.

God's Factory of Human Life

We must teach children that God creates all human life and nonhuman life. We must teach our children that God creates nonhuman life to keep us alive in His Universe. We need to teach our children to thank God for giving us the opportunity to live with all our brothers and sisters throughout Humanity.

Our students should understand that every woman's body contains organs that collectively are called "God's Factory of Human Life." God creates all human life inside of a woman's body. God creates and develops a fetus inside of the woman for approximately nine months before the newly created child is born.

There are many hundreds-of-thousands of people out there that do not think about the role that God plays in creating a human life inside of a woman and in helping to bring that human life into the world during childbirth. Most people do not give God credit for creating a new human life. They take a pregnancy for granted. They think that a pregnancy has nothing to do with a Supreme Being.

Our students must understand that a man and a woman must share passionate loving intimacy to convince God to create a new human life inside of God's Factory of Human Life. God creates a new human life in response to the desire that a man and a woman must achieve parenthood.

It is God's joy when He will present a new human life in the form of an infant to his or her parents. The parents of a new human life honor God by accepting the responsibility of being the parents of the new human life after childbirth.

How Can Young Adults Hurt God?

Children and young adults can do many things that might hurt God. They might not realize what they have done to hurt God until it is too late.

Children and young adults can hurt God by using illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and by using a weapon. They can hurt God by emerging as substance abusers both when they are in school and after graduation from high school and graduation from college. Children and young adults that choose to abuse recreational illegal drugs very much hurt God.

Unmarried young adults that abuse birth control and engage in regular sexual activity hurt God. God always wants sexual activity between a man and a woman to help Him to have the incentive to create new human life inside of the woman's body.

Men and women that have decided to refuse to attempt to achieve parenthood very much hurt God. It hurt God when a man tries to make numerous male partners pregnant. It hurts God when a woman makes numerous female partners pregnant. There are some sexual behaviors that God can no longer tolerate. Our young adults must understand that about God.

Kids and young adults hurt God if they commit a crime as juveniles. God tries hard to keep His kids and young adults out of trouble. It is so sad when God sees one of His young adults in handcuffs. It is painful for the community to see a young adult member that is slowly disappearing from the community because he or she is young adult that has decided to start committing crimes. We must recognize the existence of God in our lives and we must stop hurting Him while ignoring His power in our lives.

What Is God's Discipline?

God does not want to hurt a child or a young adult when he or she has done something wrong. God wants to confront the child or young adult peacefully in his or her mind. God can try to help the kid or young adult that he or she is in deep trouble. God will tell him or her that no one will tolerate what he or she wants to do wrong repeatedly. God will tell the kid or young adult that if he or she will not stop his or her misbehaviors voluntarily that they will face major punishment that will cause them pain and suffering.

God repeatedly tries to reach kids and young adults that show the intent to break the rules in their school and/or to commit a crime. God wants to save their lives. God comes to a point when there is nothing more that He can do in the kid or young adult does not want to understand the consequences of the rules that he or she is breaking or the crimes that he or she is committing.

God tries to work with educators and with the Criminal Justice System to be as forgiving and as merciful as possible when it comes to punishing a kid or a young adult. God does not want any of His kids in juvenile detention. God does not want any of His kids in a psychiatric facility. God does not want any of his kids or young adults in a substance abuse rehabilitation facility.

God wants to make sure that a student will receive psychiatric treatment and psychotherapy if a student's misbehaviors are related to a mental illness. God and the Holy Spirit want the school and the courts that are involved in deciding the students discipline and fate to come to understand these things.

God is still trying to understand how to discipline our kids and young adults so that He will not lose them to incarceration. God wants incarcerations to end. It is a dream to end incarcerations that may be a little unrealistic.

God Will Lead Us to Help

God is there to help our kids and young adults when we they need it the most. God is there to stop our kids and young adults from committing crimes. God is there to forgive our kids and young

adults for committing crimes and for breaking school rules. God is there to lead our kids to medical professionals and law enforcement officers that can help them in their time of need.

God wants our children and young adults to understand that they must alert law enforcement, the police, and the principal of the school if they have evidence that a fellow student has a weapon or is coming to school under the influence of illegal drugs. Children and young adults must report any fellow student that expresses the intent to hurt themselves and/or to hurt others to 911 as soon as the student sees the threat.

There are times when we will need psychiatric treatment. It is fine if a child or a young adult must take medication to treat a mental illness while he or she attends a grammar school, a high school, or a college. It is important to make sure that we can give medical treatment to any students that might show evidence of the intent to inflict harm upon himself or upon others before something horrible happens.

It is fine for a student to discuss his or her problems with a psychotherapist. A psychotherapist can help a student to respond to his or her medications and be a positive influence in his or her school.

Our Substance Abuse Crisis

Advanced Substance Abuse Training

Our substance abuse epidemic is the most crisis that has ever confronted our schools, our kids, and our young adults in the history of education. We cannot allow our kids and young adults to find out about drugs out on the streets. We cannot just allow them to experiment with illegal drugs and alcohol without giving them guidance from God and from our schools.

We must work with God and with the Holy Spirit to develop substance-abuse training programs that can help God and the Holy Spirit to reach our kids so that they can save our young adults' lives. We must seek to work with God and the Holy Spirit to teach our students the truth about what they must look forward to if they experiment with illegal drugs and alcohol. We must teach them how easy it is to destroy themselves by using alcohol and dope on the streets.

We must work with God and with the Holy Spirit to the kind of life that our young adults can look forward to if they want to make a career from being a drug kingpin or a drug dealer out on the streets. We must show our young adults what life in incarceration would be like for them if they were ever arrested for dealing drugs.

God and the Holy Spirit can help us to understand how to develop special programs that will help our educators to understand how to educate our kids and young adults about the risks and consequences that they will face from God if they want to disgrace God by using illegal drugs and alcohol. Our student must understand that God will punish them for trying to become substance abusers. Our kids and young adults must understand that God no longer tolerates student substance abusers. Students will stop using illegal drugs and alcohol one way or the other.

Life in Incarceration

Kids and young adults must try to understand what life is like in a prison or in a correctional facility. It is boring. It is a same-gender living environment. It is depressing because there is nothing to do in that place than to think about how you have destroyed yourself by dealing drugs and by enjoying being a substance abuser. You must worry about your own personal safety because your cellmates maybe rather violent. You must be careful because you might say something to offend a fellow inmate and he might come after you to try to kill you. You cellmates may try to rape you. They may be high-risk candidates for the transmission of sexually transmitted diseases such as HIV.

This horrible life is not what God wants His kids and young adults to achieve. God cannot believe that His love for His kids and young adults may not be enough to save them from suffering in incarceration. God cannot believe that our schools can teach algebra and English Grammar but none of them teach students about substance abuse awareness and about substance abuse rejection and prevention.

God and the Holy Spirit can no longer tolerate this situation with their kids and young adults. They will stop their kids and young adults from facing this kind of pain and suffering soon. Our schools must respond to a mandate from Humanity to teach our students to stop falling for the con job of illegal drugs on the streets.

Loneliness and Homelessness

Our kids and young adults have never experienced homelessness. They have never slept on park benches in forty-degree weather or through a midnight thunderstorm. Our kids and young adults have never been in a homeless shelter. They have never faced starvation. They have never faced poverty.

Substance abusers do face these problems. The lives of substance abusers disintegrate into a state of loneliness. That means that it comes to a point with them where no one seems to care about them. They either reside in incarceration or they live as homeless people on the streets with no income.

Did God plan this to happen of any of us when we were born? God would never want us to face such a nightmare for the rest of our lives if He would remember the joy and the happiness that He brought into the world when we were babies, toddlers, and kids. God could not consider the future to believe that one of His babies could face this kind of pain and suffering.

Why is it that God cannot fix this problem? Maybe it is because we do not care about the kids and the young adults that continue to fall into the endless cycle of substance abuse in this country. There is absolutely no one that is there to educate our kids and young adults to reject alcohol and illegal drugs when they are in grammar schools, in high schools, and in colleges.

God wants to reach these kids that are at high-risk for substance abuse. However, their schools taught them something wrong. Their schools taught them to ignore the presence of God in their lives. Their schools forgot to teach them to pray. Their schools forgot to teach them to go to God for guidance. Their schools did not care about what would happen if their students would at some point become hooked on drugs. We must deal with this crisis now. We cannot continue to offend our

relationships with God by allowing our kids and young adults to fall apart like this. We must do something to stop this.

Drug Dealers Hurt Humanity

Our kids and young adults must understand how God and the Holy Spirit feel about drug dealers. Drug dealers hurt kids and young adults. Drug dealers disrupt the economy. Drug dealers allow hundreds-of-thousands of people to face substance abuse rehabilitation and incarceration all over the world every year. They incapacitate the ability of young adults and adults to function in their schools and in their jobs.

Drug dealers are responsible for destroying thousands of families every week. They are responsible for destroying tens-of-thousands of marriages every week. They are responsible of tens-of-thousands incarcerations every week.

They like to get paid with cash to be compensated for destroying peoples' lives by convincing them to do dope. They like to destroy the God's relationships with His kids and young adults.

Drug dealers make God cry. God feels a profound sadness sees how wasted the victims of drug dealers appear to Him. We have stop being immature about this problem. We must work to solve this problem by working with God and the Holy Spirit to save humanity from the dangers of substance abuse.

Understanding Concepts in Dope 101

How does a kid or a young adult know what crack is? What is heroin? What is a crack pipe? What is Meth? What is Cocaine?

Should they learn the effects of these drugs by taking them at a party or should they learn what these substances are in a Substance Abuse Training Seminar?

Our kids and young adults must know what the threat to their lives is before they can be intelligent and can reject it. Why is it that no one once to go into our schools to talk to our young adults about illegal drugs and how to reject illegal drugs? Does the aristocracy of this country care about students that get their first lessons about illegal drugs on the streets instead of in Substance Abuse Education Training and Awareness Seminars?

What is an addiction to dope? What is substance abuse rehabilitation? Where do kids learn about these concepts? Do we care enough to teach them about these concepts? Is it that only substance abusers should understand these concepts?

We must stop scamming our kids and young adults. Our job is to keep our kids off dope, off alcohol, and off tobacco by teaching them the facts of life about these substances when they are kids and young adults. Our kids and young adults must know what really goes on out on the streets. We cannot lie to our kids and young adults.

Our kids and young adults need advanced training about Issues in Substance Abuse Prevention so that they can make the right choice to stay off illegal drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. That makes sense.

We must expect our kids and young adults to turn their peers into the authorities if they have evidence that their peers are using illegal drugs.

Drug Dealers and Weapons

Drug dealers are paranoid. They believe that law enforcement is out to get them. They think that they must protect themselves against bodily harm if a drug deal goes bad on them.

Most drug dealers believe that they cannot conduct their business of dealing drugs without carrying a concealed weapon with them. They want to be sure that they will have an advantage if a client tries to betray him or her during a legitimate drug deal.

Therefore, it is so dangerous to exchange cash for drugs with a drug dealer. There is always a possibility that an undercover police officer that might see the deal. Narcotics officers may crash the deal and it could turn into a gunfight. The drug dealer would have no sympathy for life or death at that point. The buyer could be mortally wounded. The dealer might be dead.

That is another reason why it is a bad idea for anyone to try to buy dope from a drug dealer in a public place that is in the plain view of law enforcement agents.

Situations involving drug dealers and weapons happen occasionally. There is no way to know just how many times police and SWAT Teams confront a drug dealer with a gun.

We must teach our children and young adults about the multiple threats to their lives that exist if they do business for any drug dealers for any reasons.

Drug Dealers and Organized Crime

There are probably many drug dealers and drug kingpins that do business with organized crime families in the United States. These families conduct money laundering activities and international drug trafficking activities for drug kingpins in the United States.

How does a drug kingpin in New York City transfer a payment of \$50,000 for a shipment of crack that has come from Central America without being detected? Organized crime is all about getting the \$50,000 to disappear in New York and to reappear in Central America. That is a money laundering scheme that can be operated by organized crime.

Organized crime families are also violent. Their members are not afraid to try to kill anyone. You may be the target of a death threat if you get one of their drug dealers in trouble anywhere in the United States.

Drug trafficking is an incredible challenge for organized crime. They are always trying to walk ten steps ahead of the feds. However, it is not a good idea to be the target of a death threat you are responsible for getting anyone in their organization in trouble. Many people that deal with drug dealers do not know that they are also dealing with organized crime.

It is better to play it safe. Stay out of trouble from the time that you are a young adult. Stay off the dope when you are a young adult. Stay off the dope for the rest of your life. Save your life before it needs to be saved.

Substance Abuse Can Destroy Families

It is impossible to maintain a husband to maintain a relationship with a wife if he is a substance abuser that is refusing to go into substance abuse rehabilitation and to go off dope. The man's wife or girlfriend will leave him. Nothing can save his relationship with his wife or girlfriend if he does not want to get off the dope.

The most incredible pain that a parent could suffer is to have a young adult son or a young adult daughter that is a substance abuser. It is difficult for a mother and a father to cope with the failure of a son or a daughter in a grammar school or in a high school because he or she has chosen to be a substance abuser.

Kids are horrified when bad things happen to a father or mother when either the father mother has a chronic substance abuse problem. The parent that is a substance abuser can become violent when he or she must come to understand that he or she must leave the house.

It is lonely when a woman's husband or a woman's boyfriend is arrested for dealing drugs or for being in the possession of drugs. It is lonely for the woman when her husband or boyfriend is arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol.

A wife or a girlfriend will see these problems and will have to decide whether end her relationship with the boyfriend or husband. It is a sad story for any man to lose a girlfriend or a wife for being high on drugs or for drunk driving. We must warn our kids to never drink an alcoholic beverage before you are about to try to drive. We must feel sympathy for the members of the families that have been destroyed because a family member decided to be a substance abuser.

Substance Abuse Destroys Students

Abusing alcohol on South Beach in Florida used to be a staple of spring break for college students. How many undergraduates bring huge numbers of cans and bottles of alcoholic beverages into dorms, fraternity houses, and sorority houses?

How many high school students have tried to use illegal recreational drugs in parties or at hangouts in the streets of their communities. How many of them have abused performance enhancing drugs? How many of them have abused drugs that had been prescribed for other persons such as a girlfriend or parent? Where does a high school student get the money to buy illegal drugs from a drug dealer?

Substance abuse among young adult high school probably does not last for very long. Their school will catch them under the influence of illegal drugs. A police officer will arrest him for being in possession of illegal controlled substances. Parents will commit a young adult son or a young adult daughter in a substance rehabilitation facility. Unfortunately, the young adult may be released from his grammar school, his high school, or his college.

Young adult substance abuse disasters happen for two reasons. First, a young adult is exposed to very intense negative peer pressure to do drugs. That is to use alcohol and to use illegal drugs. Secondly, parents allow their young adult sons and daughters to socialize with other young adults and adults that are bad for their son or their daughter. Parents do not care about the way that they are

exposing their young adults to bad peer pressure that encourages their young adult son or their young adult daughter to use alcohol and dope. It is too late to save their son or daughter when substance abuse has finally destroyed the life of their son or daughter.

Parents of young adults must be smarter than to expose their kids and young adults to this kind of damaging peer pressure.

Substance Abuse Hurts God

God remembers the day when he conceived His young adult. God remembers the baby pictures. God remembers the joy that the baby boy brought to everyone's life. The joy was incredible for the parents, siblings and other family members. How does God feel when He remembers that and He sees a young adult in high school or in college that has been destroyed by being a chronic substance abuser? How can God justify such a failure? What does God say as an answer when He asks Himself 'Why do I keep failing with my young adults? I create them to bring them into the world and I get this disintegration and failure for what I tried to do when I created this human being?'"

We should feel nothing but sympathy for God when he cries when he losses a precious human life that fell apart on Him for reasons that only He can understand. God has been trying very hard to understand what He cannot fix this problem. We must be merciful with God. We must work together to join Him and the Holy Spirit to begin to end is suffering from substance abuse disasters on this planet.

We have brothers and sisters all over the world that are desperately ill with substance abuse disorders. We must consider this to be an international medical emergency. We must work to solve these problems as quickly as possible. We must understand what is wrong here and what we must do to work with God to solve the problems that we are all facing.

God Gets Students Help

God Says: Our Students Need Help

There comes a time in every student's life when he or she will need some type psychological or psychiatric treatment. Students can begin to malfunction for numerous reasons. Young boys and young girls can entire puberty and can exist in a state of panic and desperation. Raging hormones can make young boys and young girls very sick.

Raging hormones are different boy young adult boys than they are for young adult girls. Young adult boys can experience unprovoked sexual arousal without any stimulus. It is very embarrassing for a young boy to experience a painful erection in public or in the presence of family and friends. Young girls must struggle with their menstrual cycles and hygiene that is necessary because of their menstrual cycles.

Raging hormones is probably the number one reason why our young adult boys and our young adult girls come to misbehave on their educators and on their parents. Puberty can become an unending psychological trauma for both young boys and young girls. Young boys do not understand what an erection is or how it works. Young girls do not know anything about what a menstrual cycle represents.

Sexual frustration in puberty can lead young adults to believe that seeking out a partner for engaging in sexual relations is the best way to deal with raging hormones. This is not true. Students must seek therapy when their raging hormones encourage them to become sexually active.

We must allow our students to have access to family planning training that will help them to understand puberty and sexual activity. We must help them to understand the risks and the dangers of experiencing sexual activity as minors and as undergraduate students. We must have family planning counseling programs for our students in all schools so that students that are struggling with raging hormones can get the help that they so desperately need.

Students and Psychiatric Care

God wants to provide immediate psychiatric care to all the undergraduate young adults that become mentally ill in our schools. God wants to detect when a student begins to show the intent to inflict harm upon himself or herself and/or others. Parents and educators must see the warning signs that something is seriously wrong with a student. They can make the decision to send the student to psychiatric and psychological evaluations.

God wants our educators, parents, and our behavioral health professionals to save the lives our children and young adult when they become mentally ill. God does not want His mentally ill children and young adults to face incarceration in psychiatric facilities or in prisons. God does not want his children and young adults to face incarceration after committing a crime. God does not want his children and young adults to disappear from society. It is so important for God to work with educators, psychiatrists, and behavioral health professionals to help our mentally ill students to have the best chance possible to function a part of society and to avoid incarceration for the rest of their lives. God loves mentally ill students.

Teaching Students to Go to God

All students are born with a personal relationship with God. All students have depended on their relationship with God for their development throughout their lifetime. God helped them how to learn to talk, to communicate with his or her parents and loved ones, and to understand how to show love for others. However, our young adults have been experiencing unprecedented pressures and problems currently.

We must teach our children and young adults how to pray in their lives. That is how they recognize that God exists in their lives. That is how they understand the basic concept that they must reach out to a Supreme Being that loves them very much.

However, God has other ways to help our students. We must teach our students to go to God for help when they need Divine Inspiration and Counseling. Our students must come to understand how to hear the Voice of God in their lives. Our students must come to understand the feeling and the understandings of God regarding the issues that they face in their lives.

There are many times in our lives when we must go to God for help and assistance. God is always there for us. God is there to love us. God is there to care about us. God is there to protect us against threats to our lives. God is there to show us His unconditional love for us and for all our brothers and sisters throughout Humanity.

We must take God's advice seriously. We must teach our kids and young adults to take God's efforts to help us very seriously. We must help our fellow students to respond to their requests for counseling and help with open arms. God is there to help our students through the efforts of himself, through parents, through educators, and through behavioral health professionals.

Right and Wrong at an Early Age

It is so important to teach our students the difference between right and wrong from the time that they are toddlers. We want them to understand what are acceptable types of behaviors. We want them to understand how they can hurt people. We want them to know how other people can hurt them.

Parents and educators must work together to help our students to understand the dangers of using drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. Our religious leaders must teach our kids and young adults about the importance of talking to God through prayer. Religious leaders must help our students to understand the benefits of engaging in daily prayer.

God does everything that He can to make sure that our students can understand the difference between right and wrong at the earliest possible age. God does not want to hurt a student with discipline because the students did something wrong because he or she did not know any better.

Understanding the difference between right and wrong is a learning experience for our kids and young adults. Part of the learning process comes from parents and educators that teach the students the difference between what is right and what is wrong. Part of the learning process comes from students that face discipline for breaking rules and committing crimes. That is when God feels the most pain over His feeling of helplessness when His kids and young adults must face painful discipline.

The Love of Teacher and Parents

God tries to help our kids and young adults through the help and love of teachers and parents. Our children and young adults must respond to the love of parents and educators.

Parents and educators must understand that much of the love that they show for students comes from God. The need to hurt a student for doing something wrong does not exist when God is part of the process of discipline. God wants parents and educators to understand that He does not like it when they use mistakes and breaking rules as reasons to hurt students through humiliation and suffering.

Loving discipline comes from a school therapist or social worker. Loving discipline comes from a psychiatrist. Loving discipline comes from parents and family members.

There are times when the misbehaviors may happen continually. Educators must see the warning signs that a student may have a psychiatric disorder. They should try to show love for the student by getting him or her a psychiatric evaluation and psychiatric treatment.

A loving God wants us to show compassion and sympathy for those students that break a rule only because the student does not know any better. Warning about misbehavior should be quiet and peaceful. We should encourage our kids and young adults that it is in their best interests to stop offending the school and in the community by continuing to engage in their offensive misbehaviors.

Parents and teachers can show loving discipline to children and young adult that is endorsed by God. We can help our students that have behavioral problems by getting the students psychological counseling and psychiatric treatment. We can try to save the students life instead of trying to destroy it.

When Students Need to Seek Help

God watches over all our kids and young adults. God wants them to live a care free life. That means that they will have friends. They will do well in school. They will participate in positive peer groups. What happens when a nightmare replaces that dream?

Parents and educators must teach our students and young adult how to go to God to get guidance and instruction if something goes wrong in a student's life. Our religious leaders must help our students to understand that God is there to help all of us. That is especially true when it comes to our personal and individual relationship with God.

God may face a situation where peers have offered a student illegal drugs. Peers may have offered a student alcohol. Peers may have expressed the intent to acquire and to possibly use a firearm. Peer may have either joined a gang or may have formed a new gang. A fellow student may have expressed the possible intent of wanting to hurt himself or herself.

A student must understand that it is God's will and mandate for him or her to go to the principal of a school, the teachers, the parents, and/or the police department to get help in dealing with any student that poses a threat to the student body of the school and/or to the community. Any student that detects the intent to injure oneself in another student should dial 911 immediately to report that student to the local hospital. Any student that detects a firearm in a school must all dial 911 immediately. God is there to guide everyone to deal with the emergencies.

The Discipline of God and the Holy Spirit

God and the Holy Spirit can really help you to stay out of trouble. They love our students and they do not want our students to get into trouble.

However, there are times when our students show the intent to break the rules and/or to commit a crime. God and the Holy Spirit detect this. God and the Holy Spirit then must confront the students peacefully. God and the Holy Spirit help our students to understand the consequences of carrying out their plans to break the rules and/or to commit a crime.

God and the Holy Spirit want to discipline kids and young adults when they show an intent to break the rules and/or to break the rules silently before they have carried out their threat to ruing their lives. God talks to these kids and young adults. God helps them to understand what He will do to them if they accomplish the crime that they want to commit.

God and the Holy Spirit work to try to help the kids and young adults to understand that they have better things to do with themselves than to destroy themselves and to destroy their lives by committing a crime with the idea that law enforcement will not arrest them for doing it.

God and the Holy Spirit are interested in crime prevention that will stop incarcerations rather than in after-the-fact justice when a suspect has destroyed himself or herself for the rest of his or her

lives. The damage can be so severe that the suspect may never recover from what he or she has done to injure himself or herself and/or Humanity.

We need to use silent discipline that is inspired by God to save the lives of our kids and young adults rather than to be passive and to allow our kids and young adults to do one thing wrong that will allow them to destroy themselves for the rest of their lives.

Educators and Constructive Discipline

Our kids and young adults all break the rules sooner or later. There are many young adults that fantasize about committing crimes at one time or another.

What is "Constructive Discipline?" Constructive discipline encourages a student to look forward to success and happiness in school as a reward for discontinuing his or her bad behaviors. A student admits that he or she has done something wrong. A student can be terrified of the discipline that he or she will face because of what he or she has done. Then they should face a merciful principal and a merciful faculty that will try hard to help the student to recover from his or her errors.

God inspires parents and educators to use constructive discipline for their students that do not know any better than to behave in a way that is unacceptable in their school. Constructive discipline is an effort to help a student that is in trouble by exposing the student to the Love of God, to the love of the student's educators, and to the love of the student's parents.

Constructive discipline works when everyone that a child or a young adult will know shows love for him or her. That is when a student regrets what he or she has done wrong. However, the students will not face humiliation, intimidation, or the loss of classroom study time because of a suspension or expulsion. Educators must be more patient with our naïve young children and young adults that just sometimes do not know better. Sometimes, constructive discipline is part of the learning experience.

Help with Sexual Behaviors

Do young adults need to engage in sexual activity? Who teaches young adults about the consequences of under aged dating? Who teaches young adults about the dangers of under aged sexual activity and an underaged pregnancy? Who teaches our young adults about the way that the male reproductive system functions and the way that the female reproductive system functions? Who talks to them about high-risk sexual behaviors and sexually transmitted diseases? Where can our young adults go to find information about these life-threatening problems in education?

Our sexuality is part of our relationship with God. We work show sexual intimacy with a member of the opposite gender to impress God to create a new human life inside of His Factory of Human Life inside of a woman. Our sexuality works with God to help Him to bring new human lives into the world.

Educators, urologists, and gynecologists cannot just believe that our young adults must discover the answers to these questions with no family-planning counseling and with no classroom to help them to understand these issues. Obviously, we allow our students to play with fire. They have no idea about the dangers that await them when they choose their sexual orientation. They have no idea what they

are doing when they date each other. They have no idea what they are doing when they fantasize about under aged dating and under aged sexual activity.

We must train family-planning counselors and we need to place them within the reach of all our young adults in all our schools. Our students that are struggling with these issues should be able to talk about their embarrassing issues with a certified family-planning counselor in any school. We do not want our kids to resort to engaging in high-risk behaviors because we could not get them help when they were students.

Help and Substance Abuse

God should want Substance Abuse Awareness Programs to exist in every school in the United States. God will not stop until every child and every young adult will understand their obligation to Him. That obligation is to completely reject alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms.

We must warn them about that before they go start doing dope and start getting drunk. We must do that before they get committed into substance abuse rehabilitation programs. We must do that before a police officer will arrest him or her and/or them.

God want educators to send the message to our young adults. They must stop fantasizing about substance abuse. They must reject even before they use crack or meth for the first time. Our students need to understand that God does not want anyone to try to hurt them by convincing them to experiment with illegal drugs.

God does everything that He can do to help substance abusers. He has worked with the medical community and the government to make substance abuse rehabilitation reachable to mostly all substance abusers to help them to stop doing dope.

All our schools must stop devastating God by graduating students that will become substance abusers. We need education reform to stop this from continuing to happen.

Rejecting Weapons and Firearms

Our children and young adults have no need to carry a firearm the message is very simple: "Use A Gun and You Are Done." There are only two purposes for trying to use a gun. The first purpose is to seriously injure at least one human being or to seriously injure several human beings. The second purpose is to attempt to kill another human being.

It is found to think that felon will try to break into your house and will try to rob you of your prized possession. That maybe where the paranoia exists for a person's need to carry a concealed weapon. You would be looking to possibly kill an intruder if you were to have possession of a concealed weapon.

What would happen if a young adult would become ill. What would happen if that young adult would try to use that weapon to commit a crime. What if that young adult would want to seriously hurt himself and/or others with the weapon.

How would you feel if you come home from work and you are confronted by numerous law enforcement officers because your son brought a gun to school and threatened to kill someone with it?

Mixing youth, mental illness, and a firearm means that a concealed weapon can cause so much pain and suffering that using the weapon can disrupt the operation of the entire human race.

It is fine for the Constitution of the United States to say that we are all allowed to own a concealed weapon. However, that does not mean that the Constitution obligates us to own a weapon. Our children and young adults need to understand that they have the right to reject the ownership of all types of firearms. The Constitution of the United States does not make it illegal for our kids and young adults to decide to reject the ownerships of all weapons and firearms.

God and Academic Help

God and the Holy Spirit want our children and young adults to do well in school. God does not want to see a situation when exams are too difficult for students to pass. God and the Holy Spirit do not like it when some students are left behind and some students surge ahead of their other students.

God and the Holy Spirit help students to understand what they need to do to prepare for exams if their kids and young adults need that help. God helps to make the coursework easier for our students to understand. God tries to stop students from panicking if a course seems to become too difficult.

God and the Holy Spirit work to help all students to succeed in the classroom. All teachers in all our schools answer to God and to the Holy Spirit. All teachers want their students to succeed in the classroom. God guides His teachers to do everything that they can to help our students to get the best possible education out of the courses that God's teachers teach to our kids.

God, the Holy Spirit, and our teacher are very concerned and very hurt when some of our students fall behind other students. That will change. The government needs to enact Education Reform Legislation that will help them to develop all types of programs to help our kids.

Our kids need help from God. God wants our kids to succeed on the same level. Our Extra-Learning programs will help us to make sure that all students can learn at their own pace. Extra-Learning Programs will reward students with rewards for effort, improvement, and achievement.

God and Family Planning Issues

Responsible Sexual Activity

God and the Holy Spirit would want all future Family Planning Courses to teach our kids about how to engage in responsible sexual activity. What is responsible sexual activity?

Responsible sexual activity is when a man and a woman that are free from infections of sexually transmitted diseases engage in loving intimacy to produce a pregnancy and the creation of a new human life in God's Factory of Human Life in a woman's body.

Irresponsible sexual activity can be categorized in several ways. Engaging in sexual activity with more than 3 partners in a period of six to nine months. Not asking for both partners to be tested for sexually transmitted diseases before they begin to exchange body fluids. Exchanging body fluids with more than one person at a time with high-risk partners. Having sexual activity with multiple partners at the same time where the partners are at high-risk for a sexually transmitted disease infection.

It is hard to justify responsible sexual activity for a young adult. Young adults that want to achieve parenthood in the future must think as to why it would be necessary to experiment with birth control and with sexual activity without the intent to bring a new human life into the world while they are still in high school or in college.

Sexual activity between an undergraduate young adult man and an undergraduate young adult female in a dorm of a college campus or off campus is mutual sexual exploitation. They are hurting each other by believing that undergraduate sexual activity feels good and that it brings them satisfaction. Violating a female coed on a college campus is the worst crime that a man can commit against a female in a college.

The Creation of Human Life

All young adults should fully understand the processes that are involved in the creation of human life and the process of bringing a human life into the world.

There is nothing wrong about teaching our young adults about the anatomy of the male reproductive system and the anatomy of the female reproductive system.

There is nothing wrong with teaching young adult students about the processes of foreplay, arousal, and intercourse that work together to set the stage for the creation of a new human life.

When will a couple have the best probability of being able to conceive a human life through sexual intercourse. It would be during the three to five days of her ovulation. No one knows what ovulation is. No one knows how to predict when ovulation will happen.

Russian-Roulette Sexual Activity is when a couple just has sexual intimacy repeatedly until they hit the jackpot. A more intelligent way finds a way to impregnate a woman would be to know that the man must have intercourse with the woman during her ovulation cycle.

Our young adults deserve to understand all of this. We cannot allow our young adults to walk around to live their lives without being able to negotiate with these issues.

Sexually Transmitted Diseases

Sexually transmitted diseases represent a tragedy in our relationships with God. God has created a global epidemic of different viruses, such as HIV, supposedly to discipline us for offending Him with our sexual behaviors.

God is hurt when some of us refuse to pursue parenthood. He will not sentence us to be executed for refusing to become parents. Some people just do not have the capability to do it.

However, offending God with our sexual behaviors is a death wish. Men cannot try to impregnate other men. Women cannot impregnate women. They do not understand refusing to achieve parenthood combined with efforts to impregnate members of the same gender because they believe that it feels good infuriates God.

It has gotten to a point with God where He has been tolerating this pain and suffering for thousands of years. Now, God is so angry that people that He believes are engaged in sexual behaviors

that are incompatible with his view of human sexuality are facing the worst punishment in Humanity's history.

Our schools must lay it on the table for young adults that need to choose their sexual orientation. Our students must understand the dangers and the risks that come with same-gendered relationships such as HIV. They must also consider the benefits of achieving marriage and parenthood with a partner of the opposite gender. Having a baby is one of the most beautiful events that we can enjoy in our lifetime.

God obligates us to teach all of this to our young adults so that their STD infections will someday cease to exist.

Being Sexually Active for the 1st Time

Male and female virgins come closer and closer to deciding about when they will become sexually active for the first time. God wants to be part of the decision of a young adult to lose his or her virginity with a partner of the opposite gender.

The boyfriend and the girlfriend must understand the motive for becoming sexually active. Why would they want to be sexually active if they are in high school or if they are undergraduates in college? What would they gain out of using birth control with their partner of the opposite gender?

God puts a lot of pressure on a husband and a wife to try to work with Him to conceive a human life and to bring a new human life into the world. God puts pressure on married couples because He feels that they are ready to accept the responsibilities of parenthood. God can foresee the day when the husband and wife will help God to bring a new human life into the world. That is really approves having sexual activities between virgins for the first time.

However, God does not endorse sexual activity outside of marriage with a young adult man and a young adult woman that have no income and that are students in a high school or in a college. God cannot expect students to assume the responsibilities that are associated with a pregnancy and a childbirth. They are sexually exploiting each other for sexual pleasure at a point when they do not want to have children and just to engage in sexual activity. God cannot tolerate this arrangement.

The Benefits of Parenthood

The moment when God presents a husband and wife with their newborn infant son or infant daughter is the greatest event that a human being can experience in his and/or her lifetime.

Parenthood gives our marriage a purpose to exist. Working to develop an infant into a toddler and beyond that is a joy for anyone that experience a childbirth.

Parenthood gives us a reason to bond with God. We want to thank God for all the wonderful things that He has done for us through our lives. The greatest expression of love that we can have for God is to work with Him and with our spouse to accept a human life from Him to develop for the rest of our lives.

The love that parents exchange with a baby or a toddler makes the parents the happiest people in the world. Loving intimacy between the father and the mother of the child qualified them for one or more precious human lives that God gave to them when their child was born.

A stronger relationship with God happens when we exchange love between our spouse and our baby and/or child. We do better at work. We sleep well. We are rational. We deal with problems responsibly. Our life becomes a peaceful environment as we prepare to develop an infant into a toddler and then into a child.

The greatest event that a woman can experience is when God successfully creates a new Human Life in His Factory of Human Life inside of her body. She will always thank God for that gift that He has given to her.

What Is Rape?

There are some women that allow men to violate them. In other words, they allow men that are not married to them to enjoy sexual intimacy with the woman without a relationship and without the intent to create a human life.

Some men can convince a woman that he has only known for less than a month to engage in sexual activity with him without being married and without the intent to conceive a human life. That is one example of rape. This is what is called consensual rape.

Same-gendered consensual rape happens when two young adults or two adults agree to exchange body fluids with each other after knowing each other for less than a month.

Involuntary rape is when one partner forces the other partner to engage in sexual activity. The partners could be of the opposite gender or of the same gender.

Some women want to receive money for engaging in sexual activity with a man. That is prostitution rape or call girl rape.

God suffers when He must witness a rape. It hurts God very much to see the exploitation that comes along with people that have sexual activity for no real purpose other than to get pleasure from it. A rape can ruin a woman's life. A rape can destroy a young adult's life. We need to teach our students how to protect themselves against rape. They deserve to know the truth about rape. They need to protect themselves from the devastation of rape.

Decisions about Consummation

A boyfriend and girlfriend might have a relationship where they need to express that they are committed to each other even though they are not ready for an engagement or marriage.

Some couples seek to show a commitment toward each other by consummating the relationship. That means that they want to have a sexual encounter that will give both the impression that they are in a long-term relationship without being engaged or married. The man and the woman in the relationship have no intention of producing a pregnancy.

God is not to thrilled when a young adult man and a young adult woman want to have a sexual experience to give them the idea that they are either engage or married even though they are not

engaged or married. Consummation is not a replacement for an engagement, an engagement ring, or the status of being married.

A man's proposal for a marriage to a girlfriend is not a sexual experience. Maybe some newly engaged couples consummate the relationship right after they get engaged. We have no studies to support any ideas about the percentage of couples that consummate their relationship right after becoming engaged.

God must think that consummation is a hallucination that a sex act between a boyfriend and a girlfriend gives a relationship between a man and a woman any type of legitimate status. Maybe their relationship is a dream that will disappear in the future. Couples want to engage in sexual activity after a marriage so they can achieve parenthood. How many women could tolerate consummation as a substitute for an engagement ring or a marriage? Does God tolerate consummation?

The Factory of Human Life

God's Factory of Human Life is amazing. It resides inside of a woman's body. They are a group of organs that represent the woman's reproductive system.

What happens when God tries to create a new human life in His Factory of Human Life? It is completely dark. There is no light in there. We really cannot understand that God builds the components of a new human life. We do not know how he continues to assemble the components of the baby's body to prepare the baby for childbirth.

We wonder how God feels about people that violate a woman and that want to abuse His Factory of Human Life inside of them. God loves to create human life. However, a woman's body is the only place in which life can originate. All human life starts inside of a woman's body.

We are all part of God. God needs a man and a woman to engage in loving intimacy with each other to find the energy to begin a pregnancy and to begin constructing His Human Life. God cannot create a human life by Himself. A man and a woman must work with God so that He can begin a pregnancy.

A woman's body is a precious commodity for Humanity. We must understand the vital role that a woman's body will play in the continued development of humanity. That is because all childbirths and pregnancies will originate. This is what makes women very special to God.

What Is an Abortion?

A pregnancy happens when God creates a human life in His "Factory of Human Life" in a woman's body. A pregnancy is supposed to be a special event in the lives God, the father, and the mother of the unborn baby.

A miscarriage happens when God decides that he must end the pregnancy. Many different factors can come into consideration that can convince God to abort a pregnancy and to cause a pregnancy to end in a miscarriage.

Perhaps, the fetus may show some sort of disability. A component of an organ, such as the liver or the kidneys, may have corrupted and may have become unusable. Maybe God discovered that the

baby would have a bad heart or a damaged brain. It is very sad when God aborts a pregnancy by causing a miscarriage. God makes that decision because He feels that it is in the best interests of the parents, the family members, and the doctors that are associated with the family.

Only God has the right to abort a pregnancy by causing a miscarriage. Medical doctors are trained and certified to cure diseases to extend human life as much as is humanly possible. Doctors have no right to question God's decisions about the creation and the termination of a human life.

We cannot cause pain and suffering for God by destroying what He is doing in His Factory of Human Life to create a new human life to destroy that human life and to force a miscarriage of the pregnancy. This is very serious abuse of God's ability to be the Supreme Being that creates and maintains all human life in the Universe.

We cannot give doctors the authority to stand in front of God and to say their job is to cause every woman that they treat to have a miscarriage. Do these doctors ask God why He started to create that human life? We need to further educate our young adults about abortion theories.

God and Birth Control

There are some of us that want to engage in sexual activity without the intent to produce a pregnancy. They might want to experience the sexual stimulation of without the side effects of a pregnancy. They need to find a way to engage in sexual activity without producing a pregnancy.

Birth control is an effort to prevent God from creating a new human life, achieving a pregnancy, in His Factory of Human Life at the end or after sexual intercourse between a man and a woman.

Birth control is designed to make it much more difficult for God to begin a pregnancy and to create a new human life. Birth control is supposed to frustrate God's operations in His Factory of Human Life to create human life.

It is possible that God can become so angry at a couple that attempts to abuse birth control that He may cause the birth control device to fail. He might make the birth control device inaccessible because it would be too expensive. He might also cause so much conflict between the man and the woman in their relationship that it will disintegrate and their relationship will end.

We wonder how long a man and a woman can upkeep their sexual energy so that they will continue to need to use birth control. We all must make our own decisions about birth control.

Unplanned Young Adult Pregnancies

An unplanned teenage pregnancy is the tragedy of our community. It is so sad when a teenage girl had to give birth to a baby. It is so sad when a teenage must raise a baby as a single mother. This crisis disrupts humanity.

Why can we not warn all young adult girls about the consequences of being reckless and irresponsible in the sexual behaviors and in their sexual activities? Why can we start warning them about teenage pregnancies when they are in grammar school? Why do we not have family planning counselors in our schools that can discourage young adult girls in high schools to reject unprotected sexual behaviors until later in their lives.

It seems that our underaged girls are completely undereducated. They are undereducated about the way that God wants to succeed in their lives. A teenage pregnancy is the product of a detachment from God. God wants to help His daughter in a high school that is about to throw her life away. God wants this girl to believe that she will not face consequences for engaging in reckless and insane sexual behaviors.

God and the Holy Spirit want that detachment from God that exists between God and our young adults to end. Our young adults must understand that every human being on this planet answers to God with their sexual behaviors. You live a life without sexually transmitted diseases and with planned pregnancies if God approves of your sexual behaviors. You will live a life of unplanned pregnancies and infections of sexually transmitted diseases if God does not approve of your sexual behaviors. Our students in grammar schools, middle schools, high schools, and colleges must understand this. We must educate our young adults about the issues that pertain to God and our sexual behaviors.

Under aged sexual activity must end. Young adults are in deep trouble when they think that they have anything to gain from under aged dating combined with under aged sexual activity.

Young Adults May Face Discipline

There are many consequences that young adults will suffer for engaging in reckless and irresponsible sexual behaviors. God has no tolerance for young adults that abuse illegal drugs in the process of engaging in unprotected sexual activity.

God's students will no longer be allowed to get drunk or high on drugs at college parties. College students have better things to do than to abuse alcohol in between their classes and their study sessions.

Under aged sexual activity disrupts an entire campus. An allegation of rape should result in the dismissal of a student that believes that offensive behaviors that involve involuntary sexual activity on a college campus that involves sex acts with an undergraduate girl.

Anyone that violates a female minor in high school should face prison time. Violating a young girl in high school is so offensive that whoever wants to get away with it should do serious jail time.

Parents should know better than to allow their young adults to engage in reckless behaviors with bad peer groups. Parents must be involved in education reform that will end these problems.

God and the Criminal Justice System

Teaching Criminal Justice to Students

Part of education reform is to help students to understand how the Criminal Justice System, why it exists, and what it does for the community.

First, we need to teach our students about what law enforcement officers do to help them. Law enforcement officers work to protect the community against criminals that might try to commit crimes against the citizens of a community. Police officers make sure that the streets of a community are safe. Police officers protect homes against break-ins. They help to prevent bank robberies.

Second, why should students in grammar school, in middle school, and in high school be afraid of law enforcement? A lot of kids want to do crazy things. Some kids want to experiment with illegal drugs. Some of them want to experiment with tobacco. Many of them want to experiment with alcohol. A few of them fantasize about guns.

Law enforcement officers and juvenile courts are not allowed to tolerate kids that try to hurt themselves and/or that try to hurt others. Law enforcement officers must severely discipline any kids that use illegal drugs, that smoke, or that try to use alcohol.

God guides our police officers to find kids and young adults that need discipline for misbehaving in the community. God works with local law enforcement officers to try to find kids and young adults that need help because of substance abuse problems and for other problems that they cause for the community.

We must try to rehabilitate kids and young adults as soon as we detect that they have problems to save their lives so that they will function normally as part of our communities in the future.

Warnings from God

God has a personal relationship with every child and young adult in the world. God talks to them even though even they do not know that God is talking to them. God tries to help them to understand that He loves them. God tries to help them to function in school, in their family life, and with their peers.

God warns them against many different types of behaviors that might cause them to face severe discipline. God warns them about joining gangs. God warns them about never being in possession of a concealed weapon. God warns them about engaging in reckless sexual behaviors. God warns them about facing incarceration if they work off the books or if they try to work for organized crime.

Nothing hurts God more than when a young adult boy succeeds in a sexual violation of a young adult girl. God becomes destructive when He sees under aged sexual activity. God is very angry when a young adult boy succeeds in convincing a young adult girl to let him rape her.

God is cracking down on sexual misconduct. God is warning His young adults that He will no longer tolerate offensive sexual behaviors from anyone that lives on this planet. Our young adults had better understand when they try to make decisions about their sexual orientation.

God Guides Us Away from Crimes

God does not want us to commit crimes. We are sometimes naïve about what constitutes a crime. This is especially true of our young adult students. God guides our young adults away from committing crimes because God loves His young adults.

God wants to help our kids and young adults what the difference between right and wrong is. God helps us to understand the consequences of committing certain types of crimes.

Kids do not know much about shoplifting. God wants them to understand that they must pay for everything that they try to take out of a restaurant or of a store.

Fighting is illegal. Our young adults must understand that they could be arrested and sent to juvenile detention with other young adults. Most communities have no tolerance for it.

God does not like it when His young adults form gangs. Gangs are illegal. They try hard to do illegal things with cash and with drugs. God wants to dissolve gangs whenever we will have real education reform in this country.

God would never want His young adults to ever work off the books. God tries hard to stop His young adults from getting into any situation where an off-the-books business would offer a young adult an off-the-books job.

God really wants to work with His young adults to try to stop them from continuing to break laws only because they do not know any better. God wants to guide our young adults away from these types of crimes successfully in the future.

Consequences of Committing Crimes

Our young adults need to understand the consequences of committing crimes. They need to know what it is like in juvenile detention. They need to know what it is like in a prison and/or in a correctional facility. They need to know the result of ignoring God's repeated efforts to save them from going to prison.

Education reform would be about educating kids and young adults about the fate that awaits them in a prison after they are convicted of committing crimes. The one thing that God would want to teach our kids and young adults more than anything else is simple. No one gets away with committing a crime repeatedly without being caught for it and without facing the discipline of the criminal justice system for it.

God wants to save the lives of our high-risk students that have a harder time in trying to understand the danger that they face when they ignore repeated warnings about committing crimes on the streets. God wants to do everything that He can do to save these students.

All students will someday know what they could do wrong to be incarcerated or to be admitted to a psychiatric facility. Students will know better than to make mistakes that will result in their arrests and in their incarcerations.

God is determined to save our students. He will succeed in reaching our troubled kids. It is just a matter of time before it happens.

How the Criminal Justice System Works

The main purpose of the Criminal Justice System is not to incarcerate anyone. The Criminal Justice System tries to help kids, young adults, and adults to understand what they have done wrong. They have committed crimes. The Criminal Justice System helps them to understand the consequences that await them if they continue to commit the same crimes repeatedly.

The Criminal Justice System is there to deter all of us from committing crimes that could lead us to spend the rest of our lives in incarceration. We must learn our lessons when we have caught the attention of law enforcement and the Criminal Justice System.

There must be so many things that we can do to help people that have committed crimes and that qualify for freedom to rebuild their lives. It is unfortunate that we are facing an economy with a desperate job crisis and no way to pay to find training so that so many of us could compete for jobs.

Maybe we will be able to find ways to rehabilitate the economy in the future so that everyone will have the opportunity to work regardless of whether the person has a criminal record.

The Criminal Justice System is about stopping people from committing crimes while allowing them to preserve their freedom. No one really understands that. Prisons do not really do anything to help to resolve the crisis that our Human Family is facing with God.

A Forgiving Criminal Justice System

The Criminal Justice System does not want to send anyone to prison. They only send individuals to prison when they have no choice. That means that a criminal has persistently committed offenses and prosecutors feel that reforming such an individual to continue to be part of Humanity is impossible. The suspect cannot be reformed to work and to stop committing crimes. The suspect cannot keep appointments with his or her parole officer. He or she cannot get an on-the-books job. The courts and prosecutors have exhausted their options with such a person. They must incarcerate him or her.

The same problems happen with patients that commit crimes because they have psychiatric disorders. They must meet regularly with their psychiatrist and with a therapist. They must take psychiatric medications responsibly. If they continue to commit crimes, they continue to be a threat to themselves, and/or they continue to be a threat to others then the courts must incarcerate the patient in a psychiatric facility.

The courts give these people so many chances to try to live a normal life as a free person. Sometimes, nothing that the Criminal Justice System does works to rehabilitate these people.

We can create new programs to help our young adults to not have to meet this kind of fate in their lives. We need to work with our kids and young adults to stop this from continuing to happen with them. They are clean and sober. They do not have criminal records.

Our kids and young adults are the hope of our society, the hope of our nation, and the hope of Humanity. We must work with them to start over again. We can see a brand new human face with that we can achieve with our kids and young adults. We can end this cycle of suffering once and for all.

Our kids and young adults are the salvation of our society and of our human community.

Trying to Avoid Incarceration

The Criminal Justice System cries when it must incarcerate an under aged juvenile. It is painful for prosecutors to see our kids disintegrating in their schools and in their communities. Our prosecutors and public defenders work so hard to rehabilitate our children and young adults. There are times when our kids and young adults are so insane that they do not know any better than to commit a crime.

Kids and young adults must learn the difference between right and wrong from someone. Who is a mentor for our kids and young adults? Most schools do not employ mentors to counsel and to

watch over our kids and young adults that are at high-risk for committing crimes. We must help students to understand the what our students can do wrong to help them to escape incarceration.

Kids and young adults must understand that they will be arrested if they use illegal drugs and if they become drug dealers that try to sell drugs out on the streets of a community. They must understand the consequences of being substance abusers. They must understand the realities of facing God's discipline for trying to hurt themselves and for trying to hurt others with their intent to commit crimes and with the intent to hurt themselves and/or others.

We need to repeatedly warn our kids and young adults about how easy it is for them to commit crimes that warrant their incarceration in a juvenile detention facility. Our young adults can deal drugs. They can become substance abusers. They can try to possess a weapon. They can be under aged alcoholics. They can deal drugs. They can threaten the community with violence.

It would be a good idea to set up students with criminal justice seminars that would teach them everything that they would need to know about crimes. Our students would come to understand the dangers of certain behaviors that could cause them to be committed in a psychiatric facility or to be incarcerated in a prison.

Our kids and young adults must be warned about crimes and incarceration before they have tried to commit a crime.

Juvenile Prosecution and God's Sorrow

God cries so much when a one of His kids or young adults faces severe disciplinary action. God feels horrible when law enforcement officers have caught juveniles with illegal drugs or with an illegal weapon. God cries when a juvenile is arrested for using illegal drugs in the clear view of the community. God cries when His kids and young adults must pay the ultimate price for trying to hurt themselves with illegal drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.

Juvenile courts feel for the suffering of a juvenile's family when the courts must make decisions about a student's fate after he or she has been caught in the process in the commission of crimes. The courts do not want to elevate the suffering of the juvenile's parents and family members by being ruthless in the way that the courts can send our kids and young adults to juvenile detention. God does not want the courts and the prosecutors to become so homicidal that they will leave a student who has misbehaved and who has committed a crime without an education. All students deserve the opportunity to complete their education so that they can have a chance to live a normal life. God wants incarceration in juvenile detention or in a psychiatric facility to be the last resorts when nothing else has worked to stop a juvenile from being a threat to himself or herself and/or a threat to others.

God Reaches Out to Students

God tries to help His students to be sensible about breaking school rules and about committing crimes. God tries so hard to reach out to students that are contemplating hurting themselves and/or hurting others by committing crimes and by participating in self-destructive behaviors. God tries so hard to convince our kids and young adults to never find themselves in the possession of a weapon or firearms.

God wants to save our student's lives when it seems that no one else is available to explain these issues to our students. God can hypnotize students so that they do not know how desperate God is to reach out to them to stop them from committing a crime. God tries to contact and to communicate with students that are at a high risk for committing crimes with illegal drugs and weapons.

God is very frustrated when there are not counselors, psychiatrists, psychotherapists, and substance abuse counselors that can help our students at a time when they are considering pursuing a life of crime. Our students do not deserve that kind of loneliness. Our students deserve to have mentors to talk to when a peer tries to offer the student his or her first opportunity to use illegal drugs. Our students must understand that God is a loving force that tries to help them. However, help for juveniles is also supposed to come from the students' schools and from after-school day programs that help the students to understand the realities of committing crimes with illegal drugs, alcohol, and firearms.

The training to turn away any offer to use illegal drugs must come from God. This training must also come from our law enforcement agencies and from our educators. Our educators must know better than to allow kids to exist without training in how to reject offers to engage in substance abuse activities. Our kids and young adults also need to understand how to deal with the threat of violence that might occur during their rejection of the use of illegal drugs. God does everything that He can to keep students from facing incarceration because they believe that drugs give them a high that feels good.

Who Teaches Our Students about the Law?

We cannot expect our kids and young adults to be so perfect that they will never break the law or the rules without having any training in what the laws and rules are that they must follow. We must try to train our students about how students break the law. We must train our students about what it means to break the law. We need to help our students to understand the consequences of breaking the law.

Is it fair to God when one of His student face a suspension from a school because he or she has made a mistake by breaking a rule that he or she did not even know existed in the background? Is it fair for our schools to discipline our students because the standard of the school requires them to behave in a way that is perfect with no way for the student to understand how to understand how to behave in a perfect manner all the time?

God is very disappointed when there is no one to warn our students about the crimes that they can commit if they do not follow the warning of God and of criminal justice mentors that give them their final warnings. It is so sad that these mentors do not exist and students break the law by defying God.

God and Discipline in Our Schools

Discipline Should Be Constructive

All students break the rules at one point or another in their academic career. Most students face disciplinary action for what they have done wrong.

A student's decision to break the rules can be intentional or it can just be a mistake that a student can make because he or she does not know any better.

Nevertheless, breaking the rules in a school requires some type of discipline as a warning that God and the faculty of the school will not tolerate their problems again. Some kids very much cause anger and frustration for educators. Educators come to a point when they do not know how to effectively stop a student's bad behaviors.

God endorses the use of constructive discipline to help students to understand that they have done something wrong without proceeding to try to injure the student. God wants parents and educators to reward a student when the student has successfully stopped misbehaving. Teachers and parents must show love for the child that is facing discipline. They cannot allow the child to sense that educators and parents are extremely angry at the child and that they want to hurt the child for doing something wrong.

All schools should have students that are appointed to be mentors. These mentors will try to help the school's students to understand the proper ways to behave as opposed to the improper ways to behave. These mentors will try to help students to what not to do so that they will not make mistakes that would warrant constructive discipline or more serious levels of discipline.

God, Discipline, and Injuring Students

God will not tolerate the infliction of any physical and/or emotional pain during the process of the discipline of a child or a young adult. God wants discipline to be a learning experience for His children and young adults.

Expulsion is a death sentence for a child or a young adult. There is no excuse for leaving a student with discipline that leaves that student without an education. An expulsion is cruel and unusual punishment for children and young adults.

A suspension automatically causes a child or a young adult to fall behind all his or her fellow students. That means that the suspended student may not be able to find a way to reach the academic status of his or her fellow students by the end of the school year. That is not fair to the student and to the student's family.

We should encourage our children to pray to God when they face disciplinary action. We should encourage them to have conversations with God about what they have done wrong and how to fix the problems that caused the student to get into trouble in the first place.

God must get involved with fixing the problems that get His students in trouble. He will guide them, will talk to them, and will help educators, parents to show forgiveness and mercy upon them.

God, Teaching Right and Wrong

God has one persistent grievance against all our schools. They persistently forget to offer courses which teach our kids about the difference right and wrong. Schools forget to teach students about the dangers that await them if they choose to pursue substance abuse. Our schools do not help our kids and/or young adults to understand the consequences that await them if they engage in high-risk sexual behaviors and about how to avoid the transmissions of sexually transmitted diseases.

Our schools do not talk to our young adults about the dangers that they will face if they engage in under aged dating and under aged sexual activity. Our schools do not do a good job of explaining how young adult and under aged girls get pregnant in high school and in college.

God does the best that He can to save the lives of His young adults that consider dating in grammar schools and in high schools. However, there is a limit to how well His intervention will work to save a young adult's life if parents do not want to help God from helping a self-destructive young adult boy or a self-destructive young adult girl.

Something is wrong with young adults that fantasize about engaging in sexual activity without being engaged, married, or having any type of a job. College young-adult students may resort to engaging in sexual behaviors in a desperate attempt to find a marital partner, a partner that might be able to marry them after graduation from college, repeatedly until the young adult man and the young adult woman find that partner.

God wants our kids and young adults to practice abstinence during courtship. Birth control harasses Him. Birth control infuriates God when He cannot create a human life because a medical treatment is blocking Him from doing it. Any couple that abuses birth control will face God's discipline. Young adults should understand that.

Our schools must teach our students the difference between right and wrong. Our schools must teach our students about the joys and the dangers of sexual activity in young adulthood and adulthood.

God's Involvement in Discipline

God wants to be involved in the correct way to discipline our students. The process begins even before our students have done something wrong.

Our students deserve the right to understand God's Ground Rules for this day and age. Our students must understand how they can make God happy. Our students must understand how to make our students understand the difference between student behaviors that make Him happy and student behaviors that make Him sick.

All school in the world answer to God. God works with educators and with parents to try to help them to understand that they must find psychiatric treatment and psychological counseling now or that they will face a young adult that will be committing crimes and will be facing incarceration for the rest of his or her life.

God encourages the parents of students that show a pattern of misbehavior to seek to put the student under psychiatric treatment. God encourages students to understand the consequences of incarceration that may follow if they do not stop offending their parents and educators.

God Cannot Forgive Murder

God is devastated when one of His children causes the wrongful death of another human being. Homicides are such a problem in the United States that God needs to do everything that He can to help our kids and young adults to understand the consequences of committing a murder. God wants His educators to talk about the suffering that God feels when He does not authorize someone's death within Humanity. Our students must understand the suffering of God when He knows that someone is

going to kill another person with a weapon and that God is completely helpless to stop that attempted murder.

However, the Holy Spirit does guide law enforcement homicide detectives to the suspect that probably committed the crime and that caused the wrongful death. No one gets away with murder. God will hunt you down and he will try to either kill you or to incarcerate you for committing murder. God will cause you to disappear from the face of the Earth if He knows that a suspect has committed murder.

Why do our schools not teach our kids and young adults about the consequences that will await them if they use violence against another person? Why do our schools not teach our kids and young adults about murder? Our kids and young adults do not understand murder. They do not understand lifetime incarceration. They do not understand execution for committing murder. Who will volunteer to form an organization that will teach our kids and young adults something simple. Young will suffer and you will be tortured for the rest of your lives if you try to seriously injure someone, if you attempt to kill someone, or if you try to kill someone.

We need to stop suicide attempts and homicide attempts by getting God and the psychiatric community involved in a relentless effort to teach our entire population that murder and suicide are not valid options for anyone.

Does Puberty Cause Misbehaviors?

Students may lose their sanity when they must face puberty. Young boys and young girls that start facing adult issues can become very sick. Most educators do not understand the humiliation that young adult boys and young adult girls go through when they should begin to develop their ability to achieve a pregnancy with a partner of the opposite gender.

Raging hormones can cause a girl to be rebellious and inconsiderate toward the feeling of her parents, educators, loved ones, and friends.

Boys can be very embarrassed by unprovoked sexual erections that happen anywhere without any sexual stimulation. This kind of problem can start to happen at any age. This problem is the number one reason why young adult boys will seek to engage in under aged dating.

Girls can feel panic and humiliation when they must report to school while they are having their menstrual period. They have no idea what has happened to them. They have no ideas about how to deal with the hygiene requirements during and after a menstrual cycle. Mothers do the best to help their daughters.

God helps and guides educators to deal with students that face these stressors.

God, Firearms, and Violence When Students of Victims of Violence

God is so sad when His students are the victims of violence. God cries when He sees His students that have been wounded and that have been killed. God shares His grief with Humanity.

God believes that the time has come to start to teach our kids and young adults to reject the ownership and the use of firearms. God does not see any constructive purpose for using firearms in the community. God does not understand why we need to use firearms to protect our homes from intruders. That statement paranoid and it is unprovable.

Why are our schools graduating mentally ill graduates that are a threat against themselves and that are threats against Humanity? These types of students can go through school with the potential to destroy life with psychiatric disorders that are not detected. How can our parents and teachers miss this kind of threat in a student that is so mentally ill that he or she can use violence to destroy life at any moment?

Why can we not train our students against using violence to solve our problems. Why is it the opinion of our schools that their students should not have any education about crimes with weapons and illegal drugs that can cause them to disappear from the face of the Earth? Is it that our educators do not think that these issues are more important than algebra and U.S. History?

So, our school's graduates only learn that what they have done is a crime that carries a serious penalty of lengthy jail time if they commit the crime. Why are our schools making God sick by not training our students in criminal justice issues to save their lives from incarceration?

The Consequences of Using Violence

The use of violence is illegal all over the world. Law enforcement agencies do not tolerate violence in the United States. The United Nations does not tolerate violence anywhere in the world.

Why are we not teaching our kids and young adults about the consequences of resorting to violence to solve our problems? Why is it that our schools are not teaching our kids and young adults about what types of behaviors constitute violence?

Why are we warning our kids and young adults what will happen to them if they engage in domestic violence? A suspect is automatically put under arrest for using violence against a family member or another person in home or an apartment for using violence against someone else. Our kids and young adults should understand that.

Our students should understand aggravated assault, attempted murder, manslaughter, and murder. Our students should understand the prison time that they will face when they attempt to commit any of these four crimes with a weapon or with a firearm. A suspect that tries to commit any of these crimes can look forward to fifteen years to life in prison and a possible execution also. Why is it that our students do not understand that they qualify for an extended residence in incarceration in a prison and correctional facility when they use a firearm to commit any of these crimes. God agrees with the sentences that felons receive for these types of crimes that they commit.

Life in Incarceration

God wants all kids and young adults to understand the life that awaits them when they qualify to reside in incarceration after any one of them has committed a crime.

You are in a same-sex environment where a fellow inmate can try to rape or to kill you at any time. You get three meals with food that is good for some inmates and bad for other inmates.

A jail cell usually has no radio and no television. There is no place to read a book. You face a total detachment from your family, and from your boyfriend or girlfriend on the outside.

It is so violent in these situations that inmates can try to get into a fight at any time. It can be a life-threatening situation if a gang of inmates try to injure you or if they try to kill you.

Do you have the capacity pray to God in such a nightmare? What can God tell you if you qualify for incarceration. Do you ask for forgiveness? Do you continue to ignore God? Do you blame God for all your problems? Do you want to hurt God for not stopping you from facing the devastation that God feels that you deserve?

God wants to end incarcerations as we now know them. Incarcerations accomplish nothing for humanity. Incarcerations are a waste of human potential. It is an inhumane way to detach a human being from Humanity for the rest of His Life. God is more forgiving of our sins and crimes as is the Criminal Justice System.

We want to work with God and with the Holy Spirit to help our kids and young adults from needing to face incarceration in their lives. We need to train them about how to be law-abiding citizens that will bring happiness to God and to Humanity.

The End of Firearms

It would be such a better world if we could convince our students and young adults about the con job or owning a firearm. Firearms serve absolutely no constructive purpose in a person's home or in a person's car.

What can you do with the ownership of a firearm? You can try to rob a bank. Young can get fifteen years to life in a correctional facility for trying to rob a bank.

You might have a bad hair day that would include a fight with your spouse. It might be so bad that you might use your weapon to kill her and then to commit suicide.

You might be a drug dealer. A drug deal might go wrong and you would have to use a concealed firearm either to injure or to kill the offender in the failed drug deal.

Someone might try to break into your house. Calling 911 might not be appropriate because it would take too much time for police officers to arrive at your house to try to deal with the intruder. You would choose injuring or trying to kill the intruder yourself and then to call 911. It might be safer to protect your home from intruders that having a firearm in this situation is better than calling 911.

The idea is to believe that a firearm serves a constructive purpose. We should reject any idea that any of us would really need a firearm. We have nothing to gain by using a firearm to hurt anyone.

No Justifiable Wrongful Death

We cannot stand in front of God and to try to justify our intent to hurt our brothers and sisters for selfish motives. Showing hatred toward our brothers and sisters to a point where we show God that we are considering expressing the intent to seriously injure or to kill them is not something that God tolerates.

God has no patience with anyone that expresses the willful intent to hurt himself or herself and/or to show the willful intent to kill himself or herself. God has no patience with anyone that expresses the intent to injure and/or to kill his or her brother and sisters. God does not want to hear about selfish motives when He is dealing with excuses that we use to justify the way that we show the intent to hurt each other.

Wrongful deaths are deaths that are caused by a person or circumstances that are beyond God's control. We never accomplish anything by hurting or killing one or more of our brothers and sisters. We devastate God when we think that Humanity tolerates a wrongful death for justifiable motives and reasons.

War is illegal. God under no circumstances will tolerate a state of warfare between one nation and another nation. No two nations can stand in front of to declare that they must kill each other because they have no choice. God has no way to understand how entire nations can threaten to start fire fights with each other because they have no choice but to do so.

The decision to behave like this is consistent with psychiatric disorders. We cannot justify the hatred that helps us to generate the energy to show the intent to injure and to kill member of an entire nation.

God wants to stop wrongful deaths. God and only God is authorized to make decisions about life and death as far as Humanity is concerned. God takes a human life away from us when He wants that to happen. We have no right to kill someone without the authorization of God.

Peaceful Confrontation Versus Violence

We must look to solving our disputes with our brothers and sisters through peaceful confrontation and not through violence. God wants us to show love for Humanity by negotiating peaceful agreements with those of our brothers and sisters with whom our conflicts exist. God wants us to reject violence to resolve our conflicts with our brothers and sisters all over the world. We have no right to ask God to give us the authorization to use violence to solve our disputes with other brothers and sisters and/or with other nations.

We must be mature when we face God. We must try to stop God's suffering by ending our conflicts with each other in a peaceful manner that will make God happy and will not make God to suffer. God suffers when we express hateful thoughts about each other. That must stop. We must look to God for the love and guidance to forgive our brothers and sisters all over the world for the way that they have made us suffer. We must show love for them by working with God to negotiate agreements with them to stop the conflict, the intent to hurt each other, and the expressions of hatred that we express toward each other that injure God and Humanity. God deserves that from us.

Conclusion

What God Does for Our Students

God does many things for our students. We must look up to God for help to learn how to function from the time that we are babies. We must learn how to love others that show so much love

for us when we are infants and toddlers. God helps parents to teach us how to talk, how to walk, and how to love his or her parents and family members. Infants and toddlers respond to the love of God.

God helps our children to learn how to speak and how to understand their parents and others when they speak to the child. God wants toddlers to start to talk as soon as possible. God want His children to show love for his or her parents and family members as soon as possible after he or she is born.

God is responsible for helping parents to developing a baby into a toddler. God then works with parents to develop a toddler into a child. Then, God plays a major role in developing a child into a young adult. God works with His kids and young adults to try to work with parents and educators to develop them properly.

God has an individual relationship with each of our infants and toddlers. God is responsible for 80% of their development. That include physical development, speech development, and social development. God then helps to prepare a child for preschool and for grammar school. God helps teachers to teach students how to read and to acquire basic skills that they will need in the future.

The bottom line is that God develops infants into toddlers and children that know how to share God's Love with others and to respond to the love of God from others.

All Students Need God in Their Lives

Our students need the existence of God in their lives to develop properly into adulthood and to achieve parenthood. Parents have an obligation to teach toddlers and young children to pray to God from the time that the kid is a toddler. Parents must introduce the existence of the presence of God in a to that child as early as possible.

God tries to build an attachment to His kids from the time that they are infants. God tries to guide them in their preschools and in their early grammar school years. God helps his young toddlers to perform the basic functions of daily living. God silently disciplines toddlers and children if it is possible to do so before the teacher and the parents detect that the student has done something wrong.

There are times when God would benefit from sending a student for a psychiatric evaluation and for psychiatric treatment. God wants that so that His students will not drift away from Him to become criminals that will face incarceration. God wants our students to receive psychiatric care when it is necessary to save a student's life in the future.

God makes it easier for parents and educators to understand the needs and issues that infants, toddlers, and children will face in their lives. God is part of the way that young kids study for exams. God is the way that educators achieve success in their jobs. We are all thankful for that.

Public Versus Private Crisis

All students in all schools need to understand the existence of God in their lives. Our kids and young adults must understand how to pray to God, how to communicate with God, and how to answer to God when they drift into a crisis.

Public school students tend to want to ignore the existence of God in their lives. It seems like no one really encourages them to pray to God. No one helps them to understand the benefits of working with God to solve problems. They do not worry about their destiny that comes from God. They do not understand that God created them. They do not understand that all human and nonhuman life comes from God.

Public schools tolerate this because The Constitution of the United States sets a mandate for the Separation of Church and State. The Constitution has no right to obstruct the God's Relationship with each one of our public-school students in the United States. Why do religious and parochial schools give their students an advantage by encouraging them to engage in daily prayer? So, parochial school students have a right to engage in daily prayer in their schools while the Constitution of the United States takes the right to daily prayer away from public school students. This is the way that federal courts interpret the constitution in relation to the education that our kids receive in all our schools?

We cannot put down the Constitution of the United States. However, no document in the world can tell human beings in any of our schools that they are not allowed to pray in such a school because of the way the court interpret the Constitution. The Constitution is not a document that is designed to obstruct a public—school student's ability to pray to God when attends classes in a public school. This kind of doctrine promotes a detachment from God and encourages public school student to reject the existence of God in their lives. That is a tragedy in education that must end.

How Do Our Students Find God?

It is very important for all of us to find God in our lives. That can mean several things. We engage in daily prayer. We try to receive guidance and help from God. We try to help others at the request of God. We try to achieve our destiny. We try to achieve parenthood. We try to be successful in our career.

We have found God when we can have a conversation with God. God is always there to talk to us about our problems and concerns. It is important for all of us to understand that we are all Part of God. God is part of our lives. God wants to hear about what we are going through in our lives.

God has no problem in helping us to resolve our problems and to stop the confusion that we are feeling in our lives. God wants to love us through the persons and professionals that can help us through our crisis. God can help us to understand the difference between right and wrong.

God can help us to find ways to meet a future spouse. God can help to prepare us for a career. God can help us to prepare to achieve parenthood. These accomplishments are related to find the God that exists in our lives.

God will always be part of our lives to bring us joy and happiness if we can talk to Him and to respect the role of Supreme Being that He plays in all our lives.
