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Introduction

God feels pain when His Children have to face a lifetime of joblessness and incarceration.

God has to hurt us when we try to destroy ourselves with drugs, alcohol, and weapons. We are all part of God. God will not tolerate anyone's ability and repeated efforts to hurt himself or herself. God will try everything at His disposal to try to stop the endless cycle of self-destructive behaviors that exist with substance abusers and individuals that work to commit crimes with weapons.

Either we want to develop a new human life or we do not want to develop a new human life. Taunting God by engaging in sexual activity that is an effort to create a human life while simultaneously trying to stop a pregnancy hurts God. Telling God that you and a partner want a new human life and then trying to prevent God from creating a new human life at the same time is very hurtful to God.

A woman's body is God's Factory of Human Life. Do we have the right to authorize the destruction of God's efforts to create a new human life inside of His Factory of Human Life? Do we have that kind of jurisdiction over God's rights, abilities, and decisions when it comes to the creation of human life inside of a woman? God creates all human and non-human life. What gives us the right to destroy God's efforts to create and to develop a human life inside of a woman if God is the responsible party for creating a human life in God's Factory of Human Life?

Nothing hurts God more than a man and a woman that want to reject His efforts to award them the opportunity to develop a new human life that they will bring into the world with God. God feels pain when he loses His efforts to create a new human life because of an abortion.

Killing is unacceptable and is not justified under any circumstances. God cries when members of His Human Family a wrongful death. God hurts when mentally ill people die because they could not acquire the medical and psychiatric treatment that they would have needed to stop their suicidal and homicidal behaviors. Justifiable killings are never justifiable. We hurt God and our relationships with God no matter what. Wrongful deaths disrupt and devastate Humanity. This kind of thing has to end in the future. Mentally ill persons that try to destroy life and that try to make it justified for law enforcement to use deadly force should get the psychiatric treatment that they will need so that law enforcement officers will someday cease to use deadly force.

The Roles That God Will Play in Our Lives

God has all of us under surveillance. He watches over all of us.

He helps us as students to understand our coursework. He helps us as babies and toddlers to understand our parents, friends, and families when they will talk to us. God helps parents and loved ones of babies and toddlers to understand the baby's thoughts and the toddler's feelings.

Sometimes, God gives us ideas that will change our lives. That idea might be an invention, it might be a creation, or it might be a path to a new career.

God helps us to function in our relationships. He helps us to understand what we might be doing wrong in our relationships and what we need to do to correct our behaviors so that we can come to enjoy healthy relationships. God helps us to understand the needs and the issues that confront our children and young adults. God guides us and teaches us to guide our children and young adults as responsible and productive parents.

God brings special people into our lives when we face conflicts and injuries. Doctors, therapists, nurses, law enforcement officers, lawyers, judges and court employees fulfill their purpose by helping Humanity when any of us show signs of pain, suffering, and/or distress. God recruits an Army of Special People that work to heal our pains and to recover from our injuries and illnesses. They also protect us from harm at the hands of anyone that has an illness that causes him or her to be a threat to himself or herself.

God sometimes would want to recruit anyone of us to serve as part of his team that will serve Humanity. He definitely plays constructive roles in all of our lives by helping others to help us. We must all believe that God's Good Spirit lives in all of us. We must believe that God wants all of us to play a constructive role in the progression of God's Human Family.

How God Deals with the Destruction of Human Life

It is illegal for any human being to destroy another human life. A human being succeeds in destroying a human life when he or she causes a detachment between the soul and the body of another human being. Sometimes, we can portray death to be necessary and that God and Humanity can tolerate it. However, we do not create human life completely as human beings. We do not have the right to claim a human life to death under any circumstances. God does not tolerate the idea that murder is allowable in certain situations.

Those of us that are part of Humanity must have access to behavioral health counseling and medical treatment when we can detect that we pose a threat to ourselves and/or to others. We must try to help such individuals by offering them medical treatment, psychological counseling, and religious counseling. We want individuals that have become detached from God to reattach to God and to stop being a threat to themselves and to their fellow human beings in God's Community of Human Life.

God punishes anyone that makes an effort or efforts to injure and/or to destroy human life. God will not tolerate excuses to justify any human being's efforts to destroy human life. We must find the cause of the problems that cause us to believe that such a person needs to face death in order for all of us to preserve life. Any wrongful death completely disrupts God and Humanity.

We are part of God's Creation to love God and to love each other. We cannot find excuses to have hateful thoughts about each other. We cannot continue to have sick fantasies of ignoring God's love for us by continuing to fantasize about injuring and destroying human life. We cannot continue to ignore the suffering, sorrow, pain, and the tears God who is our Creator. We deeply hurt God when we repeatedly fantasize about hurting others and of killing others. This epidemic of thinking that leads to the murder or the attempted murder of human beings is a problem that could possibly destroy God's Human Creation and God's Universe.

Thinking that we have something to gain when we try to hurt ourselves or to hurt others is false and removed from reality. Thinking that can contribute to the thinking that can justify murder is a psychiatric disorder. We must provide psychiatric counseling, psychological counseling, and religious counseling and support services in an effort to help these poor people to understand that Humanity and God will forgive them for having their harmful thoughts about destroying life. Our doctors and counselors, as well as our religious counselors, can help people that dream about the destruction of life to try to reach out to God for forgiveness and for help. We have to be willing to help our brothers and sisters while assuming that they suffer from psychiatric and behavioral disorders and not that they are evil and deserve to die.

God loves all of us no matter what we have done wrong. God is struggling to rid His universe of evil and of the destruction of human life. He has given us our prophets, our Holy Spirit, and our creation here on Planet Earth. The time has come to have sympathy for God. We have to stop his suffering finally by stopping the senseless violence and warfare around the world. We have to show love for him by showing love for each other. We must reach out for each other with love and not hatred.

How Does God Punish Us?

God is a very patient being. He is very forgiving of us. He deeply cares about all of us. The last thing that God would ever want to do to us would be to hurt us. He would never want persistently to hurt us for a long period. God wants our relationships with Him to be productive and free of pain and suffering.

We have to understand The Laws of God and The Laws of Humanity. God and Humanity will punish us if we continue to break The Laws of God and The Laws of Humanity with no attempt to respond to discipline. We tell God and Humanity that we will continue to hurt ourselves, to hurt others, and to hurt God regardless of the discipline that we will be facing.

Many types of behaviors and actions can deeply offend God. Stealing and adultery are two crimes that are in violation of the Ten Commandments. It is illegal to kill someone. God wants to incarcerate a person for life for murdering someone else. God may feel offended by a person's sexual behaviors. That might lead to the transmission of a sexually transmitted disease. Students may attempt to abuse birth control. That might lead to an unplanned pregnancy.

Prison is a type of punishment that is boring that really accomplishes nothing in the end. Prison life is a waste of time.

What would make prison time more productive for those that have committed crimes for various mistakes? What happens when a person has robbed a bank because he and his family are starving when he cannot find a job in a weak economy? What if a young adult mistakenly brings a gun to school and faces expulsion even though that what he or she did not know what he or she was doing was illegal and against the rules? What happens when a young adult drug dealer has tried to make a career with dealing drugs because he or she cannot find a job? Might this happen be because he or she dropped out of high school and was never able to get a job to support a family?

When do such people deserve sympathy and help as opposed to torture, pain, and suffering? We expect God to forgive us for our sins, crimes, and mistakes. Why is it that we cannot forgive others who have destroyed themselves simply because they have not known any better? What do we really accomplish by ruining such an individual's life for the rest of his or her life for a crime that we will leave in the past and will not happen again?

We want our brothers and sisters to continue to be part of the Human Community. We want our brothers and sisters to enjoy forgiveness, sympathy, and rehabilitation from their past mistakes and sins. We want our pain and suffering to stop. We want God's suffering to end. That dream begins with each of us. We must contribute to God's happiness by helping those that have fallen into a trap that causes them to feel punishment and to hurt God to rejoin a human community that misses all of them.

Crime prevention is better than After-The-Fact Justice. We can teach high-risk individuals to avoid the commission of crimes through aggressive efforts to promote Crime Prevention Programs. That can replace the vast number of persons that we would punish by incarceration and other penalties.

What Offends God about Our Behaviors?

God loves all of us no matter what we do to offend Him. He tries very hard to forgive us for our misbehaviors. He tries to help us to rebuild after tragedies have victimized us. He employs others to help us in our times of need. God answers our prayers when we ask Him to help us to forgive our fellow brothers and sisters for the way that they have hurt others and us.

We can offend God when we conspire to injure human life. We may think that we have something to gain from injuring human life. We may think that it is justified to hurt others in some circumstances. We may feel confident that we will not feel retaliation from God when we have the authorization to hurt or kill others because we have excuses to do so.

We offend God when we cannot provide psychiatric counseling, psychological counseling, and religious counseling to those who give us excuses to be hurtful and aggressive toward them. They give us reasons to believe that we are justified in our intent and efforts to hurt them because they suffer from untreated behavioral disorders and psychiatric disorders. We must see them as human beings that have a psychiatric illness before we think that our only options with them are to hurt and to try to kill them.

It probably offends God more that we cannot get these poor people the help that they may need in order to stop them from being a threat to themselves and/or a threat to others. It is probable that most people that commit crimes suffer from some type of untreated or mistreated psychiatric disorder. God does not manufacture evil human beings. Sometimes, human beings can become ill with a psychiatric disorder and can feel the justification to be a threat to themselves and to others.

God did not create Humanity to be in a never-ending struggle to find excuses to justify the intentional efforts to injure and to kill other human beings. We are obliged to love God and to love our brothers and sisters live with us in God's Human Creation. God is deeply offended and hurt when we have harmful thoughts about hurting each other and of hurting ourselves.

We do not completely understand that sexual activity is a direct connection to God that allows Humanity to work with God to create and to bring new human lives into the world. God creates a new human life when a man and a woman show intimacy with each other in a way that asks God to conceive a new human life that he will present to them during childbirth. They then will work with God to develop a new human life and to welcome him or her into the human community.

It deeply hurts and offends God when individuals engage in sexual activity while trying hard to stop the process of conception. We also offend God by engaging in promiscuous behaviors when a person will have sexual activity with numerous partners without the intent to conceive.

We must also understand that a man cannot impregnate another man. A woman cannot impregnate another woman. We also do not have the right to choose our own gender or to reject our own gender. Efforts to impregnate members of the same gender can offend God. We must ask ourselves what sexual activity between members of the same gender would really ultimately will accomplish for the partners and for God if a conception of a human life would happen.

How Does God Deal with Divorces?

A marriage is a contract between a man and a woman. The contract states that they will work with God to participate in the process of conception. They will also work with God to develop one or more human lives as part of their life-long relationship and marriage. It is a promise that a husband and wife will make in front of God that they will stay together for the rest of their lives. They promise that neither the husband nor the wife will abandon the commitment to develop the kids in the relationship and in the family.

A husband and a wife betray God when they decide to file for divorce. This is especially painful when children and young adults are involved. God suffers when a father or a mother is absent from a child or young adult's upbringing. God feels sad when the kids will suffer during a separation between a mother and a father.

God does not just allow a husband and a wife to walk away from each other. God has special ways of communicating with them in order to help them to fix what is wrong with their marriage. God tries hard to help the husband and wife to seek marriage counseling and to feel guilty about how the separation is hurting their kids.

God wants to help the couple to understand what they are doing wrong that is causing so much conflict in their relationship. Several things might be going wrong for them. The woman might not be able to continue to tolerate birth control. The husband may have tried to enter into an extramarital relationship with another woman. Substance abuse that deals with alcohol and drugs may be taking their toll on the marriage. Unemployment or underemployment may also be causing the family to start to fall behind on paying the bills and being able to feed the kids. The pressure of dealing with the young adults that have raging hormones can also take their toll on the husband and wife.

God never wants to give up on a marriage. He wants a husband and a wife to work out their differences and to stay together in their relationship. God forgives them for the way that they have hurt each other. God wants them to remember the joy that He felt when He presented His new human lives to them. It was the happiest days of their lives when God presented them with their sons and daughters. God had been so proud of the happiness that He felt with the father and the mother. The babies had grown into toddlers seemingly overnight. God worked with the husband and wife to develop the babies and toddlers into fully functioning children. The babies and toddlers grew to love their parents and fellow siblings.

Achieving the conception and the development of human life is the greatest achievement that a husband and wife can experience. God wants them to experience the development of human life together and not as single parents. God is there to employ marriage counselors, substance abuse counselors, psychiatrists, and psychotherapists to help married couples to stay together.

God loves our parents. God wants our parents to continue to love us and to love each other. God will do anything that he can to preserve the family unit, which is the foundation of our society and our way of life. God is there to save our relationships with our spouse and our children.

God and the Criminal Justice System

God disciplines us in many different ways. Our parents give us warnings about the difference between right and wrong. Our teachers discipline us when we misbehave in school. Other adults discipline us when we do something wrong at work or in a job training course.

The underlying problem for God is that He wants all of us to remain part of the Human Community. He wants to stop members of His Human Family from facing incarceration and from disappearing from His Human Creation because they did not know any better than to commit crimes without being able to have access to the medical and psychiatric treatment that they would need to avoid being a threat to themselves and/or a threat to others. God does not create human life to lock up in a building just to exist there while doing nothing with any contact with God's creation.

We must work with God to teach our children and young adults how to play by the rules. We must teach them the consequences that will follow them if they commit any one of a number of different crimes. We must focus less on prosecuting children and young adults. We must focus more on educating them about the dangers of substance abuse, high-risk sexual behaviors, use of weapons, and resorting to violence to solve problems.

God should work with the Criminal Justice System to create a new generation of children and young adults that will have unprecedented training and experience in dealing with understanding the difference between right and wrong. These children and young adults would completely understand how to commit crimes and the consequences that would follow if they were to commit those crimes. We must warn our children and young adults about how God punishes us for breaking The Laws of God and the Laws of Humanity. We must let them understand that God is there to guide them away from situations that might lead them to commit crimes and to face punishment.

Inmates should receive psychiatric and psychological counseling. They should receive vocational training. They should receive religious counseling. They should have a Probationary Detention Center to live in after the prison releases them. They should leave a prison with an agenda to find internships that The Department of Justice would sponsor.

God considers criminals to be human beings. We want to work with God to forgive criminals. We want to have sympathy for what the hardships that they have faced that has led them to resort to a life of crime in order to survive. We must work with God to help these poor people to regain any possible standard of living that they can have after what they have done to themselves and to others. Eternal punishment for them would just be overkill.

Our ultimate goal is to convince our children and young adults to form an alliance with God that would guide them down a road that would lead them to a life that would be free of committing sins and crimes. Their relationship with God would protect them from facing prosecutions, illegal narcotics, prison time, and homelessness.

We all hope that we can develop programs for our schools that can help our kids and young adults to work with God and with our educators to find a way to stop them from facing the dangers that would lead them to endure the punishment of the criminal justice system.

We Are All One Human Family

We all have one single living being that has created us and that is responsible for keeping us alive and in existence. We all answer to a One True God. We are all the same.

Race really does not exist in the truer sense of the word. Where our ancestors lived has no bearing on who we are in the eyes of God.

We may have different religious faiths. However, we all recognize God as Our Creator and our Supreme Being. We may call God by different names. However, the Supreme Being remains the Supreme Being no matter what you might want to call Him.

God wants all of us to love each other as if we are brothers and sisters that are part of the same Supreme Being and that are part of the same Universe. God expects us to understand that we may live at different points on this planet but that we still should care for one another as if they were our next-door neighbor.

Our suffering where we live disrupts and injures the entire Human Family throughout the world. The suffering that our brothers and sisters are enduring throughout the world deeply hurts us here at home. We belong to one nation. That is the Nation of Humanity. The different countries are provinces that God oversees. However, we have always been the Nation of Humanity and we will always be one Human Family that answers to One True God.

God is working with us to try to end the violence, the pain, and the suffering that we are now facing. This suffering has disrupted the lives of every member of Humanity. This situation deeply hurts God when we feel the need to seek to injure and to kill others. We cannot justify excuses to injure and to kill our brothers and sisters in other parts of the world.

Why would our brothers and sisters want to hate us to a point where they would resort to mass murder? This is the result of a contagious psychiatric disorder. This type of disorder can convince others and us around our peer group that killing is justified even though killing has no real justification. A human being can face a complete detachment from God when this type of a psychiatric disorder convinces him or her to hate members of God's Human Family and to resort to murder in order to accomplish something.

We must have done something wrong in the past if they want to kill us now. Is killing us the right way to discipline us for what we have done wrong in the past? We answer to God and we have to deal with our brothers and sisters in other parts of the world with sympathy and patience. We must answer to their grievances against us. We must not be arrogant and think that killing people will solve our disputes and conflicts with God and with our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We have no right to use derogatory language to intimidate and to humiliate our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We cannot claim that God creates human life that is evil. God does not create human life that is evil. We must work with God to make sure that our brothers and sisters will get the medical and psychiatric treatment that they need so that they can understand why it is wrong for them to fantasize about destroying human life. We must seek to help them with kindness and forgiveness. We have nothing to gain by solving our problems by threatening them with violence and murder.

What is God's Plan for Humanity?

Will Humanity continue to face its pain and suffering forever? Will we continue to resort to violence and to the destruction of human life? We will still have to endure poverty, illness, and death for the rest of eternity. Will we continue to fall away from God in a way that will ruin our lives, and the lives of our children, and in the lives of our children's children?

God has a different idea for His Human Family. God wants to end our suffering. He wants to end death on the Planet Earth. God wants to stop His children and young adults from falling away from Him. God wants our children and young adults to stop developing into people that can injure themselves and that can injure others.

God wants our schools to train our children and young adults to become law-abiding citizens. God wants His kids and young adults to find psychiatric and psychological counseling when they can become a threat to themselves and a threat to others. God wants all of His kids and young adults to succeed in school. He wants to stop the cycle of failure in education that causes our students to get in trouble with the criminal justice system.

God wants to end violence. God wants to end human illnesses and suffering. God wants to end violence and murder. God wants everyone to have the same standard of living. God wants our economies to produce acceptable jobs for all of us.

We must be forgiving of our brothers and sisters when they do not know any better than to resort to antisocial behaviors in order to try to solve problems. God is forgiving of us. We must be ready to be forgiving of others.

God wants all of His sons and daughters to understand the consequences of crimes such as drug dealing, substance abuse, murder, stealing, and assault. We have to stop the cycle of failures that cause our young adults to continue to fall into incarcerations and into drug rehabilitation centers by creating intervention programs that would directly connect with God.

World leaders always find excuses to be angry with other world leaders. God wants all of us to recognize that no one is evil. Destructive behaviors are a product of a psychiatric disorder. We have to treat persons with psychiatric disorders with dignity, respect, and sympathy. We do not just want to point a weapon at them as a last resort.

God wants to make sure that all persons that have the tendency to want to resort to the destruction of human life and to injure themselves to receive involuntary medical treatment and religious counseling. He wants that to happen to young adults in order to stop the endless cycle of violence that continues to convince our young adults to abuse themselves and to commit crimes.

God wants the Human Family to evolve into a network of human beings that will solve their differences through peaceful confrontation and not by threatening to kill each other. God wants Humanity to find Him. God wants all of us to show love for our brothers and sisters. God wants us to train the newest generation of international psychiatrists and psychotherapists to help those who need help to get it before they try to hurt themselves and to hurt others for unacceptable excuses.

Why Do Religions Exist?

We all have to come to recognize the existence of the One True God. We have to try to understand the Laws of God. We have to understand the personality and the attitudes of God. We have to understand what we have done wrong with God and what we can do right with God.

We have to learn how to communicate with God through prayer. Our prophets taught us how to recognize the need that God has had to receive messages from us and to hear about our grievances and issues. The prophets taught us that God wants to know about the issues that confront us and to understand how He can help us with our problems.

We had to come to understand that polytheism, the belief in the existence of multiple false gods, was and is completely unacceptable. Our religions teach us to respect and to recognize a single One True God. He is Our Creator. God sustains our existence as human beings. God's love for us gives us a purpose for existing in the world.

We had to understand the Laws of God. We had to come to understand that God does not tolerate the destruction of human life. Murder is incompatible with our relationships with God and with the existence of humanity. A murder or wrongful death disrupts the entire human race. Humanity feels grief when someone has murdered another human being. Sometimes, we feel the loss throughout the country and throughout the world.

We have to understand that we must respect God. Our prophets taught us how to show respect and affection for God. Our prophets invented rituals and ceremonies that would help us to connect with God on a daily basis.

We have to understand the origins of Humanity's relationship with God. We have to understand the history when humanity first began to encounter God after God created humanity. It would benefit us if we could understand the teachings of the early prophets. That would help us to build our own individual relationships with God. It would also allow us to understand just how far our relationships with God have progressed since the beginnings of human history.

We need to read about our prophets. We need to understand what our religions teach us about issues that pertain to our role within God's Human Family. Religions help us to understand how God feels about all of us. Religions help to introduce us to our individual relationship with God. Religions help us to form stronger relationships with our family members, our girlfriends and boyfriends, and our peers.

We must try to have the type of relationship with God that our prophets had. We must try to honor God as our prophets honored God. We must learn how to respond to one another during peaceful time and during high levels of stress by remembering what our prophets sought to teach us.

Our prophets helped us to find the road that would help us to try to find God. Our prophets gave us a new beginning with God and with each other. They have helped us to build science and technologies by convincing God to help us to develop science and technologies. We are so thankful that our prophets founded the religions that introduced us to our relationships with our One True God.

How Do We Find God?

Sometimes, God is everywhere that we go. We see evidence of the existence of God in a park or in a shopping mall. We can see images of God when we see people's pets on leashes walking down the street in our local communities. We can look at a fruit or a vegetable and wonder how God created the mechanism that created the fruit and the vegetable. Did God create the Sun? Will the Sun ever cease to exist? The Sun is an obvious image of God because it supports all life here on the Planet Earth. The Sun is part of the mechanism of God that creates a fruit or a vegetable.

We can walk around in our community and exist in our homes without really thinking about how to find God even though images of God exist everywhere that we exist. The real magic of God is when He creates a baby. That is when we come to realize that just how powerful God can be. However, most parents do not give God the credit for the creation of a baby after childbirth.

What happens when we find God? He can talk to us about our problems if we find Him. God can give us advice about how to deal with our problems at that point. God can help us to find a fiancé. He can be an excellent matchmaker. He can help us to work with our spouse to develop a human life and to proceed with childbirth. He can help us to grasp our job tasks at work and to do everything that we can to keep our jobs. He can help us to make it through our schools by helping us to with exams so that we can graduate. God can give us counseling so that we can avoid abusing drugs and committing crimes.

What is the first step toward trying to find God? We have to pray to God. Our prophets taught us about prayer. We should talk to God in our minds. We should ask Him for guidance, support, sympathy, and assistance. We should understand that God does care about all of us as individuals. God is there to help each one of us. God will listen to our concerns and then will try to guide us down the right path.

Another way that we find God is by starting a premarital relationship. We can court a person of the opposite gender to try to work with God to create and to develop human life. The love that a boyfriend and a girlfriend will show for each other will help both of them to find God. That means that they could be successful in working with God to bring new human lives into the world.

We can find God in our schools. We try hard to understand what it takes to work in Corporate America or for the government. We can ask God for guidance and support so that we can succeed in our studies. That help can make us more successful in our efforts to become fully functioning adults.

We find God by trying to do what we believe he wants us to do. We find God when we are successful in loving our family members, our spouse, and our children. We find God when we make significant contributions to the livelihoods of the communities that we live in. We find God when we reject high-risk behaviors such as substance abuse and criminal activity. We find God when we help God to develop His Human Family by working with a spouse to bring new human lives into the world.

The love that we share with others is the love that we share with God and is the love that God shares with us.

How Do We Understand That Each of Us Is Part of God?

The Spirit of God lives in all of us. God uses part of His own existence to create human life. God gives us free will. God gives us the opportunity to choose between right and wrong. God does not force His will upon us. However, the energy that sustains our existence as human beings comes from God. That makes all of us Part of God.

We do not know if God is or is not perfect. We are not perfect even though we are part of God. We make mistakes all of the time. Does God make mistakes all of the time? We are not ones that have the authority to make judgments about God. God makes the decisions that He makes for a reason. We are no ones to say that His Creation is defective.

Something does go wrong when a Part of God becomes detached from God and starts trying to injure and/or to destroy human life. Only God understands why some souls achieve a detachment from God. Why does a Part of God wind up in incarceration after trying to injure or to destroy human life? Maybe God is still trying to understand what has gone wrong. Maybe he has done something wrong or it may be another problem that that is not His fault.

We tend to work with God to develop human life, to work on projects that contribute to the betterment of humanity, and to show love and affection for all those that we care about when we have achieved an attachment to God. We function normally as part of Humanity when we have a healthy relationship with God. We have constructive relationships that develop and create human life.

We confront conflicts with God at one point or another in our lives. We have a responsibility to connect with all of our brothers and sisters throughout humanity and to help them, as God would want us to help them when we all answer to God when we function as part of God.

We have to work as Part of God whenever we face a person that is mentally ill and is a threat to themselves and/or a threat to others because he or she is suffering from a detachment from God. This is a psychiatric condition. It is treatable. Our goal is to help such persons and to avoid injuring the person as much as we can as we try to help him or her to reestablish his or her relationship with God and to rejoin the human community.

We have a responsibility to all of our brothers and sisters to treat persons with psychiatric disorders and that may be experiencing a detachment from God to be merciful, patient, sympathetic, and kind toward those that are less fortunate than others are. We have look to God to find ways to help any of the people that only know how to resort to committing crimes and abusing themselves to achieve any of the objectives.

We have to work with God to honor the legacy of our prophets by trying as hard as possible to help God to stop losing His children to incarceration, to self-destructive behaviors, and to resorting to violence to solve problems. We must reach out to our brothers and sisters and show them the tears of God so that they will see that the violence, the evil thoughts, and the pain just have to end. That is true because we are all Part of God. God deserves that from us.

What Is a Marriage?

A marriage is a contract between a man and a woman. It is a contract that the man and the woman make with God. The contract of marriage is a mutual agreement between the husband, the wife, and God, that they will work together to conceive new human lives and to bring them into the world. They will work together to develop those human lives indefinitely. The husband and the wife vow to stay together for the rest of their lives.

The husband and wife have to decide when they will begin to attempt to work with each other and with God to create their first child. Many factors go into the process of deciding when to try to become pregnant. The economic situation, the available daycare options, and the emotional maturity of the husband and wife should all be factors that they would consider before they make a decision as to whether to try to become pregnant.

God expects married couples to attempt to conceive human lives at one point or another. That is part of the marriage contract. God wants love to be a force that generates the energy to manufacture a human life for a husband and wife. God shares in the love and intimacy that a husband and wife share with one another.

God shares in the joy of the development of human life with the new parents after childbirth. God helps the parents understand the baby's thoughts and needs. God helps the baby to learn how to talk and to communicate his or her feelings to his or her parents and family members. God helps a baby to gain weight and to prepare to learn how to walk. God also teaches the baby several ways to show emotions such as laughter and sorrow.

The development of human life is the main highlight of a marriage that God approves and oversees. God works with parents during every stage in the development of their children. God helps parents to deal with the crises that come along with some children that may have disabilities and/or other behavioral disorders.

Parents have to be there for their kids and young adults through good times and bad times. Parents must have access to powerful resources in order to deal with a son or daughter that may have a behavioral or a psychiatric disorder. God tries hard to help parents to cope with a child or a young adult that has a mental illness. God loves all of us no matter what our disabilities might be. We have to provide the options to the families of mentally ill children and young adults in order that we can maximize their level of functioning and keep them out of hospitals and prisons. Keeping them free should be the ultimate goal of any psychiatrist's treatment plan.

A husband and wife need to work together and with God to deal with the problems that come along with parenthood in this time in human history. We have to stop losing our young adults to drugs and to alcohol. We have to convince our young adults that tobacco abuse is not acceptable. We have to prove that using firearms is completely and totally wrong and self-destructive to a young adult. We have to do everything that we can to help our children and young adults to connect with God so that God can guide them in the right direction. Young adults that move in the right direction will mean that they will stay as a successful part of the Human Family of God and will stay away from incarceration and prison. That is the ultimate goal of our parents now.

How Do We Ask God for Forgiveness?

There will always come a time in our lives when we will make a serious mistake. Sometimes we will make a mistake that will be hurtful to our loved ones and to members of the human community. We may also injure God and our relationship with God. We are generally good people when we believe in the existence of God. We feel horrible when we have to face God after we have actually tried to hurt someone in a deliberate and flagrant manner.

God works with the criminal justice system. Judges are judges because God wants them to be judges. Prosecutors and lawyers are prosecutors and lawyers because God wants them to be prosecutors and lawyers. Federal, state, and local law enforcement officers are law enforcement officers because God wants them to be law enforcement officers. They all have a mission from God to serve Humanity. They all have a mission from God to serve and to protect the communities that they seek to work to protect. They do not think about it when God guides them in their professions.

A big part of asking God for forgiveness has to do with asking the criminal justice system for forgiveness. Whether you will get forgiveness depends on several factors. Have you admitted that you have committed a crime? Have you lied about your involvement in the commission of a crime? Are you ready to express remorse and sorrow for the suffering that you have caused because of the crime that you have committed? Are you determined to refuse ever to commit such a crime or a similar crime ever again?

The criminal justice system does not want to incarcerate anyone. The criminal justice system wants us to learn our lessons and both to admit that we have committed a crime and to show a commitment that we will not commit the crime again. That should be enough for a court to release for a first-time offender or a second-time offender from prison after an arrest.

Asking God for forgiveness often times means that you will be asking the criminal justice system for forgiveness. Should God forgive us if we cannot forgive others that have committed a crime against us? What is forgiveness when we have to deal with someone that has committed a crime against us? It means that the criminal justice system will decide the fate of that person that hurt us. We will not pursue any punishment for that person in excess of what the criminal justice system will impose on the suspects that hurt us.

God can force us to seek psychiatric counseling and treatment if we continue to hurt ourselves and to hurt others without actually committing a serious crime. We need psychiatric counseling whenever we feel the need to have something to gain by hurting ourselves, by hurting others, and/or by feeling that we have something to gain by hurting ourselves and by hurting others. God wants to stop the cycle of destructive behaviors at some point to save our lives and the lives of our loved ones as well as the lives of the members of the community that we encounter every day.

God forgives us through the criminal justice system. God forgives us through psychiatric and psychological counseling. God forgives us through marriage counseling. God does not want us to face prison time because we do not want to stop committing the same crime repeatedly without an end.

What Role Should Religion Play in Our Lives?

God builds an individual relationship with each one of us. We respond to the discipline that God has over us in many different ways. We must understand that God exists before we can understand the role that He plays in our everyday lives. God can send us various silent messages at various times. God can guide us through routine activities. God can also attempt to guide us through complicated tasks that we would find to be very difficult. God is always there to help us in very mysterious ways.

Religion plays a very important role in our lives to a certain extent. We have to recognize the existence of God in all of our lives. We must understand the purpose of God. We must understand our own purpose for existing as part of God's Creation. We really must understand the types of relationships that the prophets had with God before we can actually understand how to build our own individual relationship with God.

Religion gives us the ability to have a starting point in order to try to understand the history of humanity's relationship with God. We can learn much about what God will tolerate from us and what He will not tolerate from us. We can come to understand how to talk to God through prayer. We can understand why prayer is so important in the development of the capacity to engage in active communications with God. We can see the mistakes that we made with our prophets in the past in order to learn what it means to stand before God to ask for forgiveness for our sins while showing genuine remorse.

We think about our religion when God wants us to think about him. We think about the prophets when we want to communicate with God. There are many times when we exchange thoughts with God without noticing what we are doing here. Sometimes we will be studying about the prophets and we will experience a stream of ideas that can come from God about what we are reading about a certain prophet or a certain story that we can relate to a prophet.

We can look at religious symbols when we want to find God to ask Him for help with our problems. God can guide us to His Army of Special People that he has trained and developed to help us in our time of need. These special people work for God and are committed to helping all of us to solve our problems and to bring us closer to finding God in our lives.

Who are these special people? They are teachers, doctors, lawyers, judges, soldiers, police officers, law enforcement officers, nurses, social workers, and others. They are committed to working for God and for Humanity to make this a better world for all of us. God develops Special People because they give Him many options that He utilizes to help all of us that need special help from God and from Humanity. There is a lot of satisfaction when God's Special People succeed in helping us to recover from our hardship suffering. God's Army of Special People is there because God cares about us and loves all of us. He wants us to get help whenever we need that help.

The History of Humanity's Relationship with God is a fascinating story that we read in the Holy Books of our religions. We have a lot to gain by knowing what our ancestors went through when God created Humanity and when no one believed in the existence of God. Our prophets changed that and introduced us to the One True God. That is why the legacy of the prophets and of our religions will live with us for the rest of eternity.

What Does God's Love Do for Us?

God plays many roles in our lives. His love for us does many positive things for us also. What is the difference between the love that God has for us and the love that we have for each other? There is a limit to how many people that anyone of us can love in a lifetime. God loves everyone that exists as a human being in the entire Universe. God's Universal Love is what we all have in common as brothers and sisters on His Human Family. God gives us a purpose to exist. God challenges us to be productive members of the human community. God's love for us saves us from pain, suffering, and hardship. God's love for us helps us to learn how to love others.

Love is the force in the universe that works with God and human beings to create and to develop human life. Love is a force that bonds the members of families together with each other. Their love for God gives the members of our families the ability to bond with God in relationships where God's love gives them guidance toward achieving their destiny. God's love for the members of the families of Humanity inspires us to develop a newborn baby into an adult that can work with God to begin the cycle of conception, childbirth, and the development of human life all over again.

God's love for us helps us to solve our problems. God's love guides all of us to work together as a team with God as a team leader to try to work toward solving our problems. We feel God's love whenever we recover from an argument with our spouse. We feel God's love whenever doctors and therapists work hard to keep our kids and young adults off illegal street drugs. We feel God's love when educators work extra hard to help all of our students to succeed in the classroom. We feel God's love when our family planning counselors guide our young adults to be responsible and intelligent in the way that they behave in an effort to enter a relationship or to perform in a relationship. We can feel God's love when doctors discharge us from a hospital after battling a long illness. Our doctors feel God's love when they try to exercise the healing powers of Jesus Christ.

Nothing in the world is more special than the introduction of a new life into the international human family. God's love for us allows us repeatedly to experience the miracle of conception and childbirth. God teaches us how to love others by showing love for us from the first day that we are born onto this Earth. God's love for our young babies and toddlers allows babies and toddlers to show love for their parents, siblings, and other people that are involved in their development. God's love allows caretakers to understand a baby's thoughts, needs, desires, and issues and to respond to babies appropriately. God help us to hear our babies' thoughts and to understand our toddlers' thoughts.

God's love for us allows us to enjoy a job when we can earn money in order to support the mission of developing human life with a spouse. God can guide us in our occupations and our careers so that we can work with Him to show love for His children that we care for with our spouse in our family. God gives all of us a chance to earn a living in order to continue to expand and to develop humanity throughout His Creation and throughout the universe.

God's goal is to show love for the members of His Creation until the existence of death, suffering and punishment will disappear and that he will replace that with happiness and tranquility for all of us on this Planet Earth. God's dream is that His love for us will save all of us from pain and suffering.

How Do We Show Love for God?

It is important for all of us to show love for God in many different ways. We should show caring and loving for the children that God has given us to care for after childbirth. We have to worship God through prayer and through peaceful communication. We must try to work with each other to remove evil intentions from Humanity. We must work together to help persons that want to behave in evil ways to receive psychiatric treatment, psychological counseling, and religious counseling. We must show love for God by being ready to forgive our brothers and sisters that hurt us because of they are mentally ill and are suffering from a detachment from God. We must show love for God by helping our medically ill brothers and sisters the Will of God that is to stop the violence, to stop the evil thoughts, and to stop the excuses to continue the injuries and the killing, and the paranoia that we are always out to kill each other.

We should honor God through our religious rituals and holidays. We must never forget the greatness of our ancient prophets. We must preserve the legacy of the prophets whenever we see the need to engage in senseless killing and senseless warfare. Would our ancient prophets support our efforts to justify the destruction of human life all over the world if they were to be alive today? What would they think about the conflicts between the members of the different religions?

We can show love for God by offering to negotiate a peaceful agreement between our adversaries and ourselves so that all of us will stop generating excuses for killing each other. We can show love for God by showing a willingness to forgive our brothers and sisters for behaving in a hateful manner toward us simply because they are mentally ill and need psychiatric medical treatment and religious counseling. We can show love for God by praying for the rehabilitation for those that seek to destroy lives in the masses because of a detachment from God that is part of a psychiatric or a behavioral disorder. We can show love for God by showing forgiveness for those that have tried to hurt us in the past with an idea that they have wanted to destroy life in the masses. God wants us to enter into a new era in human history where we will solve conflicts through peaceful confrontation and negotiation between our adversaries and ourselves.

We do not know how God must suffer when we try to justify the destruction of life through warfare or by "Stand-Your-Ground" thinking when you kill someone in self-defense. We believe that we can solve problems by finding excuses to kill other human beings that are part of the enemy. We hurt God, our relationship, and ourselves with God whenever we are successful at hurting or killing someone else, regardless whether or not we will face incarceration for it. We must show love for God by refraining from warfare and excuses to hurt or even to kill each other. It is better to love for God by preserving human life and by solving our conflicts with others through peaceful negotiations. We cannot continue to elevate the suffering of God by engaging in hateful and paranoid thoughts about members of organizations that want to destroy us. We can solve the problem by getting our brothers and sisters psychiatric treatment and religious counseling. We can show love for God by treating our sick brothers and sisters as if they were human beings and not as if they were not deserving of being part of God's Human Family. We show love for God by being forgiving of our very disturbed brothers and sisters that are very sick.

When Does God Want to Communicate with Us?

There are many times when God may feel the need to communicate with anyone of us. God wants to help us when a crisis arises in our lives. God wants to give us guidance and support so that we will survive a life-threatening crisis that might cause permanent damage to ourselves and to other family members and friends that relate to us. God wants to intervene in our lives whenever anyone of us or our family members need extra help to survive a problem that can overwhelm us. God wants to guide us through the process of fixing the problems for however long it takes to do so.

Sometimes God plays matchmaker with us. God wants to introduce us to a potential partner for dating, engagement, and marriage. God would want to communicate with us in order to set up a situation where he would introduce us to a potential partner. God loves to introduce a man to a potential female fiancé and spouse. God loves to guide women to a man that could become the best candidate for marriage that she could find anywhere. God wants to score big when He tries to help a man and a woman to start dating with the hope that it will develop into a marriage. That is because that is a potential situation when God will have the opportunity to bring new human lives into the world. That is the purpose of God. That is God's goal. That is what he hopes to achieve as the world's most notorious matchmaker.

Sometimes, God needs us to help others that are in need. God can guide us to help others. God can ask us to prepare for a career that will certify us as someone that the government will give a license to help others. God sees the potential that we have to enter a career where we can help Him to help others. God will ask us to join His team when He thinks that you have the potential to serve Humanity as part of His Special Team of Human Beings. God will ask us to help others from time to time. Sometimes, we may be the only person that can help God to help someone else. God expects us to help others when He asks us kindly for our help.

God communicates with us when we are ready to begin the process of participating in the process of the conception and creation of a new human life. God will guide a man and a woman to work together through intimacy in order to produce a pregnancy. God guides the intimacy of a man and a woman for however long it takes until they achieve a conception. God tries to guide us through a pregnancy and a childbirth. Our coaching from God continues throughout the development of the lives of our children.

God tries to communicate with us when we have certain types of medical problems such as substance abuse issues and the expressed need to hurt ourselves and/or to hurt others. God wants to help those who try to hurt themselves with illegal drugs to receive His help and the help of professionals that can guide them through the process of recovering from the pain and suffering of substance abuse. Sometimes, our behavioral disorder can lead us to believe that we have something to gain by hurting ourselves and/or by hurting others. God tries to communicate with us when He sees that in order to save us from the consequences of self-inflicted harm and of inflicting harm upon others. God tries to communicate with us when we try to become a threat to ourselves and/or a threat to others. He tries to stop us from hurting ourselves and from hurting others by offering to help us. We should respond positively to God's offers for help even though these offers sometimes do not work.

How Do We Honor God?

There are many things that we can do to show our respect and admiration for the role that God plays in all of our lives. We have to be respectful of the legacy of God's ancient prophets. We have to admire them and love them for introducing us to the existence of our loving One True God. We can show love for God by showing love for our family members, our kids, our coworkers, and for Humanity. We can try to understand the Will of God and to do everything that we can to do what God wants us to do. We can pray for those that are less fortunate than we are and we can offer to help them with the guidance of God. We can offer forgiveness for those that have had hateful thoughts toward us and that have caused us to fantasize about injuring and destroying life. We can honor God by bringing psychiatric and medical assistance to those that are painfully ill with psychiatric behavioral disorders and with other medical disorders that make them seem that they are a threat to us when they are critically ill instead.

The Mission of God is to continue to develop the existence of human life throughout the universe forever. We honor God by helping Him to create new human lives, to give birth to those human lives, and to continue to develop those human lives until they become adults. We honor God by showing love for our spouse and for our children in a way that is respectful for Our Creator. We must help God to achieve His purpose in the universe by working with Him to develop human life.

We honor God by working with the governments of humanity to discourage the use of violence and killing of human life to solve disputes and problems. We honor God when we will understand that we are all brothers and sisters that belong to the same Human Creation and that we all answer to the One True God that oversees all of us. We honor God when we show love for each other after an extended period of conflict and talk to each other in front of God in a way that is meaningful and constructive. We can honor God by an effort to stop calling others enemies and to start calling them brothers and sisters who are children of the One True God. We must be forgiving of their illnesses that lead us to believe that both they and we need to prepare to injure and to kill each other. God wants us to honor Him by stopping the paranoid rhetoric and the name-calling. God wants us to honor Him by showing Him that we can make peace with each other in a way that is constructive and peaceful.

We can honor God by caring for our sick children and young adults that become a threat to themselves and a threat to others. We honor God when we do not give up trying to reform and to find medical and psychiatric treatment for our children and young adults before it is too late when they commit a crime that will ruin the rest of their lives. We can honor God by creating support programs, psychiatric treatment programs, psychological and religious counseling programs, and criminal justice training programs for our children and young adults. We have to try to work with God to steer our children and young adults down the right path. We do not want to lose any of our children and/or young adults to incarceration because we could not intervene in their lives soon enough to save them. We honor God when we try to save the lives of our children and young adults and when we succeed in doing so.

We honor God when we look at people that are destructive to themselves and that are destructive to others not as evil but as severely mentally ill. We must honor God by working to get these kids and young adults the psychiatric treatment that they need before they begin to hurt themselves and to commit crimes.

What Is a Detachment from God?

A detachment from God is a serious psychiatric problem. Several aspects exist through a detachment from God. A person that is detached from God ignores God. He or she practically never thinks about God. He or she never worships God in a religious facility. He or she has no idea that sexual intercourse is a direct connection to God that works to conceive a new human life. He or she fights off attempts by God to offer help to him or her. He or she ignores God when he or she tries to injure, to seriously damage, and/or to destroy human life. He or she might try to stop the conception of human life without being sensitive to the way that it may hurt God and his or her relationship with God. He or she can come to believe that God will tolerate their efforts to hurt others and to break laws without facing the punishment of God or of the criminal justice system. Such persons have no idea that God has them under surveillance everywhere that they go. God gets to a point where he can no longer tolerate the threat that a person that is suffering from a detachment from God poses to humanity. God has to deal with such a person at one time or another.

We are all part of God. We are all in a state of attachment to God. That means that we know that we have to interact with God in order to continue to exist as part of His Universe and as part of His Creation. We pray to God. We communicate with God. We help God. We ask God for help. We respond to God's requests that we should try to help others. We work with God to help him to expand His universe by developing human life. We all have positive things to gain from a productive relationship with God that is part of an attachment to God.

Many factors can cause a detachment from God. Psychiatric disorders are probably the most common causes that contribute to a detachment from God. Psychiatric disorders make children, young adults, men, and women oblivious of the consequences that will follow them if they become a threat to themselves and/or a threat to others. They do not fully understand the consequences of being a threat to oneself and/or being a threat to others. They believe that they can hurt others without facing the consequences of what they have done. They believe that they can ignore God and that they can continue to exist as part of Humanity. Several types of psychiatric disorders can cause these symptoms.

We can help people that try to injure and/or to destroy life in many different ways if we know that they have a detachment from God. Psychiatric treatment, psychological counseling, and religious counseling can help these patients to understand that they are part of Humanity. These patients can understand the benefits of joining a Human Race that loves God and that is trying to abandon the doctrine that justifies hateful and destructive attitudes between our brothers and sisters. Our new Human Race embraces a love for God that attempts to preserve human life and rejects excuses to injure and/or to destroy human life. We must show these patients how they would benefit from negotiating with God's new Humanity. God's Family will welcome the patients that can achieve a reattachment to God while embracing the dreams and the visions of Our Great Prophets.

We are all looking for a new beginning with God. We are all looking to save the lives of those that are less fortunate than we are. We must stop our hateful attitudes and work to attach ourselves to God so that we can solve our issues with all of our brothers and sisters throughout the world.

What Are the Main Purposes of Religions?

No one knew that God even existed when He succeeded in creating Humanity. Our Great Ancient Prophets founded the Humanity's religions.

The primary goal of our religions is to establish the idea of monotheism. That means that only One True God exists in the Universe. The different religions have different names for the same Supreme Being. We have come to understand that we infuriate God if we worship false gods, idols, and evil spirits. God and the prophets established our religions in the days of Ancient Greece and the Roman Empire. The Greeks and the Romans worshipped numerous false gods. They had no idea about how they were offending and angering our One True God. The first purpose of the three main religions, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam, was to put an end to polytheism, which was the belief in the existence of multiple false gods.

How did the ancient humans learn how to talk to God? Our prophets gave those guidelines about how to talk to God through a concept that was and we always have called prayer. The prophets had to show their followers how to communicate with God once their followers became convinced that only One True God was in existence. They would repeat the same verses of a prayer repeatedly because they would not really know what to say to God or how to talk to Him without offending Him. That was the concept behind prayers such as "The Our Father."

What are the "Laws of God?" Our ancient prophets had to spell it out for our ancient ancestors about what God would and would not tolerate from us. The Jews had to follow the Ten Commandments. The early Christians and Muslims followed the guidelines of Jesus Christ and Muhammad. All of the religion talked about the difference between right and wrong. The religions talked about the consequences of committing crimes and sins in front of God.

Our ancient ancestors needed to understand that they had to allow God to play a role in their lives. The same is true today. We have to think about religions in order to understand that we have to think about our prophets in order to understand how important it is for all of us to allow God to play an important role in all of our lives.

It is hard to prove that God exists. How do we explain the existence of God to young kids? How do we explain the existence of God to our ancient ancestors? That is why our prophets invented the concept that we call faith. This is a belief that God exists even though we have no evidence that such an idea is actually true. We believe in God because we have faith that God exists. God exists because God really does exist. There has to be a Supreme Being that has created all of us and that sustains the creation that we enjoy right now. The development of the concept of faith was another feature of the ancient religions.

The religious leader established holidays, ceremonies, and rituals that would honor God. The religious taught our ancestors to honor God by observing holidays, by performing rituals, and by participating in certain types of ceremonies. The prophets and their religious leaders want their descendants to honor God repeatedly every year in order to begin to build healthy relationships with Him and to make it easier for God to forgive us for our sins and crimes.

How Does Religion Help Us To Talk To God?

Our prophets taught us that God loves us. They taught us that we need a relationship with God in order to function as human beings that are part of Humanity. The prophets taught us how to honor, to respect, and to show dignity for God. They taught us the importance of making our relationship with God a central part of our lives.

What is the underlying reality that we must face when we have to deal with God? That is that we have to form some way to communicate with God. Only the ancient prophets could communicate with God in the time of the ancient prophets. No one else knew how to recognize any type of communication with God. Our Great Prophets tried to change that. They tried to encourage us to talk to God on a daily basis. Most of the followers of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam are encouraged to pray on a regular basis.

Sometimes, we have to take prayer a bit further. We have to try to hold a conversation with God. We have to respond to guidance from God. We have to respond to a request from God. God can ask us to help someone else and we will gladly honor his request. God can try to help us in many ways that we do not understand. Most of us who have been part of the world's religions really feel the need to interact with God on a higher level than just a simple prayer where we talk and God just listens. Sometimes, we need God to talk back to us.

How do we decide what we need to say to God? We might have personal issues that we cannot resolve. It might be a marriage crisis. It might be a psychiatric crisis with a young adult son or a young adult daughter. It might be a problem with a conflict at work. It might have to do with a problem with a premarital relationship. We might want to discuss many issues with God. That is if it might be possible to do so.

God has special capabilities to guide us to resources that can help us to resolve our problems and conflicts. God has many ways to guide us to a goal or to a destination that might help us to achieve a goal. God can guide us to a certain understanding that will help us to comprehend what we have to do to get the help that we need to solve our problems. God might guide us to persons that might be able to give us help in dealing with our long list of issues. God works in many ways to help us when we successfully communicate with him to discuss our issues and our problems.

Religion introduces us to a Supreme Being that is there to help us no matter where we are and no matter where we go. God is always available to help us because of the love and affection that He always wants to show for us. That is what the ancient prophets tried to help us to understand more than anything else does. We had to understand the love that we did not know existed from God until our ancient prophets taught us about the existence of our One True God.

Religions teach us the ground rules of existing in God's Human Creation. We have to understand what constitutes a sin or a crime. We have to try hard to follow God's guidance so that we do not ever face the consequences of committing a sin or a crime. God will guide us away from committing sins and/or crimes if we have faith in the way that he tries to love us.

What is a Prophet?

No one could really recognize the existence of our One True God in the ancient times right after God created Humanity. However, God chose special human beings to act as representatives of Humanity to talk with Him about numerous issues that related to His relationships with all of us. These human beings could talk to God on behalf of all of us. They could act as trial lawyers when they would ask God to forgive us for committing sins and crimes.

The ancient prophets had a way of communicating and talking directly to God. They could have conversations with God. The prophets would talk to God about our issues. God would help the prophets to talk to the groups of people that they would represent to know how God would feel about their issues.

Prophets were human beings that were role models for all of us. They would honor God with their behaviors and lifestyles. They were committed to serving God and to helping God to reach His sons and daughters of His Human Family. The ancient prophets would set an example for us to follow. They would deserve our fullest admiration and respect.

God worked with the ancient prophets to teach us how to communicate with God. The prophets taught us that they needed to recognize the existence of a One True God. The prophets told their followers to reject the idea that they should worship multiple false gods. The prophets taught us how to pray to God when we did not really know just what to say to God or why we needed to even talk to God.

The ancient prophets taught us that it was very important to attempt to communicate with God on a daily basis. We could not just ignore God. They taught us that God is and always will be part of all of our lives. The ancient prophets taught us that we have a loving and forgiving God that deeply cares about all of us.

The ancient prophets begged God to forgive us for our sins and destructive behaviors. Some of us showed a disrespect for God in ancient times and we do that even currently. The ancient prophets help God to find different ways to forgive us for our sins and crimes. The prophets helped God to find the patience to tolerate our sins without fantasizing about hurting or destroying His Human Creation. The ancient prophets helped God to tolerate us when we would disgrace Him or hurt Him.

Our ancient prophets had a profound love for God and for Humanity. The ancient prophets wanted all of us to achieve a final peace with God. The prophets wanted to start the process that would allow all of us finally to find God and to bond with God for all of eternity.

We have to find our purpose for existing. The teachings of the ancient prophets give us the first insight that shows us why we do exist and helps us to understand the role that God plays in all of our lives. They help us to understand why all the members of God's Human Family are so important to God and to the rest of Humanity.

We should all try to achieve the same direct communication with God that our ancient prophets had achieved in their lives. We can communicate with God as they did also.

The Greatness of Moses

Moses was the Great Jewish Prophet that was on a very special mission from God. First, God wanted to work with Moses to deliver the Jews from captivity in Egypt. Moses had to use special powers from God to overpower the dominance of the Egyptians to lead the Jews away from captivity and to the Promised Land.

God recruited Moses to be the leader of the Jewish People as their most powerful prophet. He had numerous missions that he had to complete for God. He could hold conversations with God about the situations that existed between God and the Jews. God would speak directly to Moses as the representative of the Jewish people. Moses would then reveal the will and feelings of God to his Jewish followers.

Moses' most famous accomplishment was the introduction of the Laws of God not only to the Jews, but also to all of the members of the Human Family. Moses called these laws the Ten Commandments. This was the first time in human history that God presented His laws for human beings to Humanity.

Moses made it very plain and clear that God would not tolerate the worship of multiple false gods and/or idol worship. Murder was out of the question. Adultery would carry very serious consequences. Stealing would also be a very serious problem.

God called the Jews "God's Chosen People." This was because they were the first family in human history that actually recognized the existence of the One True God. The Jews were the first family to believe that the One True God was part of all of our lives and especially part of the lives of the Jews.

God promised the Jews that He would relocate them to the Promised Land. Moses was the prophet that worked with God to bring the Jews to the Promised Land.

Moses was their role model. He was their leader. He was their representative from God. All of the Jews could feel God's love through the power that God gave to the Prophet Moses. The Jews felt that God could forgive them for any sin and/or any crime because Moses gave them the impression that God's love would guide them through any crisis that they could ever face. Moses reassured all of the Jews that God was there to protect them as long as they would believe in the One True God. God wanted the Jews to be role models that would teach Humanity about the existence of the One True God in order to stop polytheism, the belief in the existence of multiple false gods, from existing throughout Humanity.

Many things made Moses one of the greatest prophets of the ancient prophets. His actions showed how much he loved God. His attitudes showed how much he loved the Jews and how much he loved humanity. His legacy continues to be a role model for us to this day because we all want to have the same connection and relationship with God that he experienced when the Jews found that the Ten Commandments were not only their Laws of God, but that they were all everyone's Laws of God.

Moses was instrumental in founding the criminal justice systems of God and the Human Nation. This may have been one of his greatest accomplishments.

The Greatness of Jesus Christ

The Roman Empire had always been a problem for God. Tens-of-millions of people would reject the One True God of the Jews and would proceed to worship the false gods of Rome and Athens. This problem would infuriate God. God had to think about what He was going to do to stop this problem from continuing from happening.

God decided to employ the Holy Spirit, an entity of higher intelligence, which is a part of God, to help Him to launch a mission that would destroy polytheism all over the world and that would convince all human that only One True God exists. God wanted only human beings to accept the existence of One True God.

God decided to send the Roman Empire, the Jews, and all of us a special prophet. This individual would be modest, a rabbi, a Jew, would speak Latin, and would have a Latin and Greek name. This Prophet's name was Jesus Christ.

Jesus' mission was very simple. He was to conduct a three-year mission that would bring about the fall of the Roman Empire by proving the existence of the One True God of the Jews and by disproving the existence of the false gods of Rome and of Athens.

God knew that the sermons of Jesus Christ would not be completely enough to provide evidence that what Jesus was saying about rejecting the false gods of Rome and Athens and accepting the One True God of the Jews to take seriously. God then employed the help of the Holy Spirit to help Jesus Christ to perform miracles to offer compelling evidence that they should take the messages of Jesus Christ very seriously.

The Prophet Jesus Christ loved all of us. His mission was to save all of Humanity by convincing us to surrender our bodies and souls to our One True God, the Supreme Being that created all of us. Jesus stopped God from having fantasies about destroying Humanity because of the practice of idol worship and worship of the false gods.

There were several reasons why the Romans and the Jews decided to try to execute Jesus Christ. The Jews felt that their relationships with God were exclusive to them and only to them. The Jews felt that their beliefs of the existence of a One True God was a Jewish concept and was not the business of any non-Jew. The thousands of Roman citizens that doubted the existence of the false gods because of Jesus' sermons and miracles alarmed the Romans. The Romans saw this as an epidemic of an illness that could destroy the Roman Empire. The Jews and the Romans decided that the only way to stop this cancer would be to execute Jesus Christ. They finally did find a way to crucify Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit worked with God to bring Jesus Christ back to life. The Holy Spirit was able to repair all of Jesus' wounds within hours. The Holy Spirit and God brought Jesus back to life within two days. This showed Humanity that no one could destroy part of God. Jesus proceeded to try to forgive all of those that had betrayed him during his crucifixion. Jesus also worked with his apostles to install Peter as the first Pope of the Roman Catholic Church. Jesus showed nothing but love for all the members of Humanity. He was instrumental for saving us from the evils of polytheism and our detachments from the One True God. The horror of Jesus' crucifixion will live with us forever.

The Greatness of Muhammad

Our ancient Arabians did not really practice polytheism that much. They were just oblivious to the concept of the One True God. That meant that they really had no way to find a way to communicate with God at all. This deeply hurt and frustrated God. He truly loved all of the inhabitants of the Arabian Territories. However, God was at a loss as to how to reach them so that He could show love for them.

The Holy Spirit then decided to recruit a special prophet, the Prophet Muhammad, to try to begin a ministry that would bring the members of the Arabian Tribes and settlements to come to understand the existence of the One True God and to have relationships with God. The Holy Spirit felt that The Prophet Muhammad had all of the qualities to start of a mission in the Arabian Territories to found a religion that they would ultimately call Islam.

Muhammad did not need to perform miracles in order to be believable when he would deliver sermons about a One True God that he would call "Allah." He talked about honoring God through the power of prayer. He talked about how important it would be for his followers to be respectful of God in their actions, words, and attitudes.

God and the Holy Spirit, what they called "Angels," guided Muhammad throughout his entire mission to convert his followers to an unconditional devotion to Allah. The same Holy Spirit or Angels guided the Moses and Jesus Christ to complete their missions. Muslims know the members of the Holy Spirit as Angels that help them on behalf of God.

God's Holy Spirit or Angels intervene in the lives of all Muslims. They try to help Muslims to understand the Will of God and to carry out God's wishes. No one understood this more than Muhammad. Muhammad understood God's will for him and God will for all of his followers. Muhammad had a mission to found Islam, to produce the Holy Book, the Qur'an, and to bring peace to all of the members of the tribes and the territories of the Arabian Territories.

Muhammad was one of our greatest prophets for several reasons. He had a deep and unconditional love for the One True God. He had a love for all of his followers. He had a deep respect for the prophets that came before him. He had a strong relationship with the Holy Spirit, which he called "Angels." His sermons were powerful and his statements about God or Allah were indisputable to his followers. He taught tens of millions of followers the importance of recognizing God or Allah in their lives. He was the prophet for the rest of us.

Muhammad in no way founded a religion that supports violence and mass destruction. He worked for God, Angels, and the Holy Spirit. He was a peaceful person that did not advocate violence as a way to solve problems between opposing groups of human beings. He would not lead his followers to try to injure God by trying to hurt or to kill themselves or to hurt or to kill others.

Muhammad created Islam as a religion that helps us to relate to God so that we can work with God to create and to develop human life. Muhammad prepared his followers to love each other and all of us. Muhammad did not create Islam to be a hurtful religion that would encourage us to hurt ourselves and to hurt others. We must pray for all of those who want to hurt themselves and to hurt others to get medical and psychiatric treatment no matter what religion of which they belong.

What Would the Prophets Say to Us Today?

Our prophets did not design our religions to manufacture violence, murder, terror, pain, and/or suffering. Our Great Prophets founded our religions to help Humanity to find God and to help all of us to understand the Laws of God. They were purely wonderful prophets that have legacies that will live with us forever.

We can imagine the spirits of Moses, Jesus Christ, and Muhammad standing on a tall mountain where they would be looking down at us now. We could imagine why they would be crying. We could see the way that Jews, Muslims, and Christians treat each other and they will ask God a simple question, "What did we do wrong that caused our brothers and sisters to have the desire to hurt each other and to kill each other like this? How could we have betrayed you like this when our mission was to work with you and your angels to save your Human Creation?"

How would God respond to His three Great Prophets? How would he justify the hostility that exists between Christians, Muslims, and Jews? How would justify the way that He cries and the way that He suffers when he has to endure total hatred that leads to violent injuries and wrongful deaths. God may ask Himself what He did wrong with the ancient prophets that caused His disaster now.

We all work with God in this day in age. However, some of us are not as willing to work with God like our brothers and sisters are can work with God. However, none of us is all supposed to become detached from God. We are all supposed to have a religious faith. We are all supposed to admire the Great Prophets and to try to achieve the relationship with God that they achieved. The Great Prophets are supposed to be our role models.

What would Our Great Prophets say about the multitudes of people that can disgrace their legacies and that proceed to injure God and humanity? Would they cry as God cries when He sees endless suffering that the Great Prophets were supposed to stop hundreds of years ago? Would they feel the same pain and suffering that God feels from our human pain and suffering?

What would Moses, Jesus Christ, and Muhammad discuss about Humanity if they could face each other while sitting down on a table? Would they express sorrow for what has gone wrong with Humanity? Would they condemn the never-ending conflicts between Christians, Muslims, and Jews? Would they ask God to send them back to try to build ministries all over again if nothing that God is trying to accomplish can solve Humanity's problems? Would they feel guilty by thinking that their ancient missions to connect God to the members of the Human Family failed in their opinion and in their eyes?

What would we ask Moses, Jesus Christ, and Muhammad if they were to hold a press conference with us? What kind of sorrow and guilt would they express over the senseless murder and suffering that we face all over the world? How could we face these prophets after the way that the members of our human family have caused pain and suffering for God and for our brothers and sisters throughout humanity? It would be interesting to hear their side of the story. Many the Great Prophets could give us some advice as too how to solve our problems by working with God and the Holy Spirit.

What is a Religion?

A religion is an effort by a large group of people to study about God and to participate in a mutual effort to work to find God. We all need to respond to our relationship with God. We need help from God in many ways. God tries always to be there to help us in our time of need. God functions in our lives in many different ways. We connect with God every time that we connect with someone that we love.

Our ancestors in ancient times could not even recognize the existence of God. Our ancestors and prophets established religion to help us to recognize the existence of God in our lives. Religions help us to work with God to fulfill the destiny that He has chosen for us.

There are several components to a religion.

There is a Holy Book such as the Torah, the Bible, and the Qur'an. The Holy Books chronicle the beginnings of God's relationships with the ancient members of Humanity. The Holy Books help us to understand that God wants to show for us. The Holy Books explain the Laws of God to us. They help us to understand the different roles that God and the Holy Spirit or Angels play in our lives. They also teach us that we have a forgiving God that wants to welcome us back into the human community even after we have made a mistake that has hurt ourselves or that has hurt others.

Another component to a religion is the religious ceremony. This is where we join a group of our fellow church members to go to a church or a temple and to pray to God simultaneously. Our religious leaders teach us more about what our Holy Books say about our relationship with God. Our religious leaders help us to find God through group worship of God, the prophets, and the Holy Spirit or Angels. God does respond to our concerns when a mass of people come together to pray to him in a religious ceremony. That brings everyone closer to finding Him and to allowing God to help him or her to solve his or her problems.

Another component of religions is the ritual. We perform rituals repeatedly over time in a way that honors both God and the ancient prophets. Daily prayer is a ritual. Holy Communion is a ritual. A Bar Mitzvah is a ritual. Daily mass is also a ritual. All religious rituals help us to connect to God.

Religious holidays help us to honor God by celebrating key points in human history that marked milestones in the development of our relationships with God. We recognize religious holidays throughout Humanity. We show respect for our ancestors when they had to struggle to find the existence of God through the ministries and teachings of the prophets.

Religions help us to try to find God. They help us to Humanity's relationships with God. They help us to understand the Laws of God. They help us to understand the penalties that await us if we hurt God or if we hurt any of our brothers and sisters. We must also understand the rewards that await us if we choose to work with God to serve and to help our brothers and sisters throughout Humanity.

Our ancestors needed religion just to recognize that God did in fact exist. Now, we can take religion a step further by developing healthy and long-term relationships with God.

What is Science?

Science is the human effort to understand the mechanisms that God will use to create, to support, and to develop all human and non-human life in the universe. Science challenges us to find God through thorough investigations, which are stronger than having a faith in God. Scientists investigate nature and the processes of nature that create all life.

Scientists manipulate the universe to create mechanisms that do not relate to either human or non-human life. These mechanisms can better the quality of life that we will enjoy as part of God's Human Creation. Scientists and engineers work with God and with the Holy Spirit to create inventions that nature by itself could not create.

God loves to help us to communicate with one another. God and the Holy Spirit love to help our scientists and engineers to create communications devices so that we can speak to our family members, friends, and colleagues wherever we are no matter what we are doing. God loves to promote communication between His sons and daughters throughout His Creation.

Science and religion can work together to help us to find God. Our scientists can try to learn how to work with God through religion. They can then work with God and the Holy Spirit to make their research and inventions to succeed and to work properly. Our initial relationship with God should start with the study of our religion and of our religious beliefs. Our work with God and the Holy Spirit should then progress through our training as scientists and engineers.

We should achieve a partnership between the scientific community and religious leaders in order to make it easier to work with God and with the Holy Spirit to make engineering projects succeed and to achieve an advanced understanding of God's Universe.

We should also work with God and the Holy Spirit through the Medical Sciences. Our doctors attempt to imitate the healing powers of Jesus Christ all of the time. All doctors work for God and for the Holy Spirit. All medical professionals rely on guidance from God and from the Holy Spirit during their studies in medical school, during their residencies, and during their careers.

Science is a further progression from religion. Science seeks to understand our relationships with God and with each other on a much higher level. Scientists want to work with God in order to save our lives. Scientists want to achieve the relationship with God that our Great Ancient Prophets achieved. Our scientists are always looking for help from a higher power to seek solutions for problems that are different to solve.

Scientists have a love for Humanity such as religious leaders do. Scientists love God just as we all love God. Scientists attempt to work with supernatural powers such as we do. Scientists seek to find God just as we look to find God.

Scientists Serve God and Humanity such as our religious leaders have done. God blesses our scientists with special powers so that they can fulfill their mission to make the Human Community a better place for all of us. They do so by respecting the legacies of our prophets and by respecting our need to find God and to participate in our religious faith.

What Are the Missions of Our Religious Leaders?

All of our religious leaders are on a mission from God regardless of which faith to which they belong. Our religious leaders have commitments to God, to the Holy Spirit, and to Humanity. They choose to serve God's Human Creation.

One of their missions is to help all of us to understand the history of Humanity's relationship with God. God created Humanity at some point. We then started to function without recognizing God's role in our lives. How did we come to understand what it was like for us and for God when God first created us? What kinds of mistakes did we make in the beginning? How did our relationships with God develop? How did we offend God? How did we honor Him? How did God come to forgive us for our shortcomings? Why did God decide never to give up on us? Our religious leaders help us to work with God to answer those questions.

Our religious leaders try to interpret the difference of behaviors and actions that are either right or wrong as they pertain to what God and the Great Prophets taught us. Our religious leaders have to interpret the teachings of the Torah, the Bible, and the Qu' ran to understand the actions and behaviors that offend God and that warrant punishment from God. God has all of us under surveillance. He knows when we have committed a sin, when we have sought to hurt others and/or ourselves, and/or have broken laws. Our religious leaders have to help us to understand that very painful consequences will await us if we violate the Laws of God that the ancient prophets revealed to us. God will also reward us for making substantial contributions to the existence of our human community.

Our religious leaders must teach us about the power of prayer in our lives. They teach us how the ancient prophets taught us about the assistance that we are eligible for if we pray to God to ask Him for Help. Our prophets emphasized that we have to communicate with God on a daily basis through prayers. The purposes of these prayers should be to worship God and to retain help from God in order to find solutions to our problems.

The Great Prophets taught us that we have a very forgiving God. God wants to forgive us for the sins and crimes that we will commit. God tries hard to find the energy to give us a second chance and/or numerous other chances to have a new beginning with Him. Our religious leaders do not want God to lose us to incarceration. Our religious leaders want God to develop us into law-abiding citizens that will be a constructive part of the human community throughout the world.

Our religious leaders would try to help us to solve our problems as if they were the great prophets that could be alive and part of our lives today. Our religious leaders try to think and to solve problems as if our Great Prophets did in ancient times. Religious leaders try to imitate the thinking and the rationalization of the ancient prophets. Our religious leaders work with God as the Great Prophets worked with God. God needs that kind of help because His Human Family needs help through this crisis.

Religious leaders can also work with scientists to try to work with God together to find solutions to our problems. It really would be a good idea for behavioral health scientists to work with religious leaders to try to bring people back for forgiveness to a loving God that would want to give them a second chance.

How Do We Resolve Conflicts Between Opposing Religions?

We must understand that we are all children of God and that we are all part of God's Human Family. We are all the same in God's eyes even in we belong to different faiths. We are all human beings that answer to the same One True God. We all answer to a universal set of the Laws of God. We have to understand that our different religious faiths do not make us any different from each other in the eyes of God.

God will not tolerate any type of violence between the members of different religions anywhere in the world. All of the followers of the Great Prophets know that murder is against the Laws of God. There is no such thing as making excuses to justify the destruction of human life. The destruction of human life is never justified in the eyes of God. God did not work with the Great prophets to create religions that would justify the destruction of life under any circumstances. We have to understand that we are liable for the same type of punishment when we seek to justify the destruction of human life as when it is not tolerable.

God does not tolerate hatred between religious groups. There is no place in God's Human Family for hatred between religious groups that leads to fantasies to injure and/or to destroy human life. Such thinking is an effort to express hatred toward God. God will not tolerate the criminalization of His religions by a life-threatening outbreak of hatred between leaders of two religious faiths. Such a situation can provoke God to punish those that are involved in hateful actions against the members of opposing religions.

We must honor God in the way that we attempt to resolve our differences with members of other religious faiths. We must resort to peaceful confrontations. We must resort to patience. We must resort to negotiation. We must extend offers of friendship. We must express respectful sympathy for the circumstances that would lead members of an opposing religious sect to have grievances against us that would give them the misconception that they would need to resolve their conflicts with us through violence.

We must remind each other through negotiations that we are all part of God. We are not evil. We have been through horrifying tragedies over time. Everyone is hurting over what has happened to us and to our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We are suffering just as everyone else is suffering.

However, we should not try to disrespect God by using violence to solve our conflicts with each other. We must understand that we answer to God. It is not our business to justify murder under any circumstances. Our Great Prophets taught us that at the beginning of human history. We still have to learn our lessons about wrongful death and murder.

God and the Holy Spirit have to be part of the peace process when individuals of different religions express hateful thoughts against each other. We must ask God to forgive us for having cruel and hateful thought toward our brothers and sisters of another religion because that is an offense abuse of our relationship with God. We must recognize members of another religion as our brothers and sisters and we must grow to try to love them.

The Power of Prayer

We can assume special powers when we talk to God through prayer. God is always ready to listen to our issues, concerns, and grievances. God wants to listen to how we feel about the problems that we face in our life. He wants to know about how we feel about the different persons and circumstances that are making life difficult for us.

Prayer helps us to understand our own destiny. Prayer helps us to understand how to achieve our destiny. God has a plan for all of us. Prayer helps us to discover that plan and gives us guidelines as to how to achieve that plan.

Prayer can also give us a direct connection to the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is an Entity of Higher Intelligence that works for God to watch over all of us regardless of what religion to which we belong. The Holy Spirit works directly with God. The Holy Spirit tries to help all of us to find God and to connect with God. It is there to make it easier for God to listen to our prayers and to answer our requests for assistance and sympathy during times of distress and suffering.

God can talk back to us when we try to talk to Him through prayer. God can give us feedback regarding the issues that we wish to discuss with Him. God can give us advice as to how to proceed to approach and to solve our problems. God has a wide range of resources that can help us in our time of need.

Prayer is one of the ways that we show love and affection for God. God wants to feel love and affection from all of us. It hurts God when we ignore Him and when we refuse to show love and affection for Him. God wants to have a powerful relationship with all of us that include the sharing of affection through prayers.

A prayer is a series of statements that we make with the assumption that God is listening to us. Children and young adults will say memorized prayers that come from the ancient prophets because they do not know how to talk to God in a more advanced level. We can communicate with God on a higher level of thinking as we get older. We have a more advanced understanding of what our relationship with God can do for us in young adulthood and in adulthood.

There are times when God will actually try to contact us. God will invite us to have a dialogue with Him. This may come at a time of a severe crisis in our lives. It may come at a time when God will need our help to save the life of someone else. Sometimes God needs us to help others. We should always be ready to help others at the request of God. Showing love and caring for others is part of the way that we show love for God. Showing love for God is part of the way that we remain human beings that have a high level of functioning in God's Universe.

The Power of Prayer is about showing love for God. It is about showing love for all of our brothers and sisters. It is about having a way to ask God to forgive us for our sins. It is a way to help God to help others that are in need of God's help. It is about receiving help from others at the request of God.

The Power of Prayer is about participating in a cycle of loving interactions with God that seek to accomplish remarkable things for ourselves and for all of our brothers and sisters throughout the world.

When Does God Try to Talk to Us?

There comes a time in all of our lives when God may feel the need to try to communicate with us even though we are not exactly praying to Him. He may approach us in many different ways when something has gone wrong. He may seek our help in trying to fix a very broken situation.

When should we take God seriously if He tries to communicate with us? We should understand that we all answer to the One True God. We should take God very seriously when He tries to come to us with a problem that He needs to solve. God can ask us questions. He can tell us what the problems are. He can explain why he has chosen us to try to solve the problem. He can try to convince us to help Him. He can guide us in our efforts to solve the problem or problems if we choose to help Him.

Some of us do not want to take God seriously when He tries to talk to us. That is hurtful and inconsiderate. God needs all of us to be part of His existence. That means that He needs to communicate with us in good times and in bad times. We can hurt God by persistently rejecting His efforts to communicate with Him especially when He needs our help.

The Holy Spirit can also work with us. The Holy Spirit will sometimes work with us on God's behalf to guide us through a difficult problem. Some of us know the Holy Spirit as a body of Angels. The Holy Spirit is a part of God that watches over all of us. It sometimes has something to gain by contacting us and by guiding us to the resolution of a problem. The Holy Spirit works in many mysterious ways. It can perform miracles. It can lead us to do seemingly impossible things. It can lead us to relieve our pain and suffering during times of crisis. We all have an obligation to respond to the requests and the communications of the Holy Spirit.

We should always evaluate what we come to believe that God wants us to do for Him. God may want us to accomplish many different things for Him. We have to determine how to use our resources to work with God and the Holy Spirit to accomplish what God wants us to accomplish. We have to think about the strategies that we will use in order to fulfill the will of God. It is very important to help God through a tough time if we will expect God to help us through a tough time.

We should have a pleasant attitude toward God when He tries to communicate with us. We should deal with God in a very kind tone of voice. We should show sympathy for the way that God is suffering because of all of the wrongful deaths and the hateful thoughts that are happening throughout His Human Creation. We must show God that we care about Him when He tries to communicate with us. We must have an attitude that show him that we have love and affection for him as well as sympathy for the way that He suffers over what we do to each other and over what we do to Him.

We can accomplish remarkable things when the Holy Spirit tries to guide us. It can help us to learn in school. It can help us to perform in our jobs. It can help us to be outstanding parents. It can guide us through very difficult times in our lives. Its guidance can lead us to accomplish remarkable things. Its intervention in our lives can also help us to seek forgiveness from God and can help us to find God afterward.

God talks to us when we need help. God talks to us when He needs us to help others. God talks to us when we need to find Him.

Does God Talk to Us When We Want to Hurt Others or Ourselves?

It is illegal for any of us to have the willful intent to hurt ourselves and/or to hurt others. God is very hurt and injured when He discovers that one of his sons and/or daughters has the willful intent to inflict pain, suffering, and harm upon someone else or upon others.

God can try to communicate with one of His children that might be contemplating the act of hurting himself, herself, and/or others. God might try to convince the person that it would not be worth it to face the consequences that would be associated with committing an act of violence against someone else. God would also warn the individual that He would not tolerate any effort by someone to inflict an injury upon himself or herself.

God's goal is to try every possible effort to convince individuals to refuse to resort to violence against themselves and against others. God can work in mysterious ways in order to stop want of His Children from disappearing into incarceration and disappearing from Humanity. Nothing hurts God more than losing one of His children to incarceration or to a wrongful death during the commission of a crime.

God and the Holy Spirit need more resources in order to stop destructive and self-destructive behaviors from continuing to cause self-inflicted injuries and serious inflicted injuries upon others. The Holy Spirit needs help from the medical community in order to make sure that all persons that pose a threat to themselves and to others will receive the adequate psychiatric care that they need in order to avoid their decision to commit a crime that may lead to a lifetime of incarceration.

God does talk to people that face incarceration because of their determination to attempt to injure and to destroy human life. God and the Holy Spirit sometimes have limited resources that they can use to save the lives of these individuals. It is so difficult for God and the Holy Spirit to feel the pain that happens when a human being faces a lifetime of incarceration because God could not convince him or her to decide to avoid violence and self-destructive behaviors to try to solve their problems.

The persistent efforts to hurt ourselves and to hurt others represent a complete betrayal of God. God cannot tolerate this type of betrayal. God must choose what discipline He will use to stop an individual's cycle of violence so that God can save more innocent lives from facing serious injuries. God and the Holy Spirit can help the individual to receive involuntary psychiatric treatment. Incarceration is the most painful punishment that God and the Holy Spirit can impose upon an individual that resorts to violence continually to hurt himself and to hurt others.

God loses His patience with individuals that will not negotiate with Him about issues that are about suicides, murders, and emotional and physical torture. It will come to a point when God will work with the Holy Spirit and Humanity to stop the self-destructive behaviors and the violence. Self-destructive violence and other types of violence are inconsistent with God's creation.

We must learn to understand the will of God before we choose to either try to hurt others and/or to hurt ourselves. It is impossible to destroy ourselves. It is impossible to destroy human life. God can reincarnate the souls of those who have been the victims of a wrongful death. Anyone that is responsible for a wrongful death must face God and the ultimate punishment for it.

What God Expects from Us When We Communicate with Him

God has a special way of communicating with us when we are babies and toddlers. God helps our loved ones to hear our thoughts when we are babies and toddlers. God plays a substantial role in helping their parents and loved ones to teach our babies and toddlers how to talk and to communicate with them.

God creates human life. What happens when a defenseless baby is born into the world? God has to work with the baby's parents and loved ones to learn how to love God and how to love others. Babies have a special relationship with God. That is why they do strange things to their parents. God is a translator that explains the meaning of a baby's mannerisms and emotions to his or her parents.

God expects babies to become social human beings when they have to deal with Him. God supervises the way that babies learn how to walk, how they use their arms and legs, how they see and hear things, and how they cry when something goes wrong with them.

Parents can help their toddlers out by teaching them to pray at an early age. This can help the toddler to achieve an early connection to God. God would find it easier further to develop toddlers if they not only know how to pray at an early age but if they also pray on a regular basis. God loves His babies and toddlers. God has a special relationship with each of His toddlers that contributes to the development of each one of them.

Young adults begin to understand that one of their responsibilities to God is to participate in the process of the conception and the development of human life. Young adults have a chaotic relationship with God. They have to understand how God feels about the consequences of high-risk sexual behaviors. God expects all of them to understand the process of conception. Our schools have no right to stop our young adults from understanding the process of sexual intercourse, conception, a pregnancy, and childbirth. Furthermore, our young adults need to see and understand why women choose to have abortions. They need to understand all aspects of the surgical procedure that is involved in the process of ending a pregnancy.

God wants all young adults to be able to talk with Family Planning Counselors to discuss issues that pertain to sexual activity with their partners. They have to make the right decisions about their sexual functioning and sexual activities with their partners.

Our adults also answer to God. God guides our adults to have successful marriages and successful efforts to participate in the process of conception. God communicates with our adults when they feel the need to end a marriage or an engagement. God is the ultimate matchmaker that introduces candidates for the possibility of a long-term marriage.

We are all part of a single human family. God communicates with us as a whole. We communicate with God collectively even though we may belong to different religions. We communicate with God in order to ask Him to forgive us for the way that we have failed Him. We ask him to help us to rebuild our lives after we have failed Him. We gladly accept His rewards for us when we honor Him and fulfill His will for us. It is just as important to show love for God when we face rewards from Him as to when we face discipline from Him. Our goal is to find a final peace with God.

How Does God Discipline Us When We Fail Him?

God and the Holy Spirit watch over all of us. They see and know everything that we do. They understand our motives when we want to do good things for humanity. They also understand our motives when we want to commit crimes and to hurt people.

God and the Holy Spirit do not allow any of us to continue to commit crimes and to hurt others without facing the justice of the criminal justice system eventually. We might face justice sooner rather than later. God's "Holy Spirit SWAT Team" works to guide all of our law enforcement officers to hunt down individuals who have been a threat to Humanity and that deserve to face incarceration. Law enforcement officers do not notice the influence that God and His Holy Spirit SWAT Team have in the way that police officers and other law enforcement officer is that experience in dealing with people that have failed God.

God can cause bodily injuries to any person that might be a threat to His community of human beings. He makes the decision as to whether the infliction of bodily harm is an adequate response to the way that an individual and/or individuals represent a threat to the human community. God tries to use bodily harm as a way to deal with these types of people as an absolute last resort.

God can disable a person that poses a threat to society by inflicting a behavioral disorder upon the person's health. Illnesses such as schizophrenia and bipolar disorder can incapacitate a person that God feels can be a threat to a community of human beings in which the individual lives. This may happen after repeated efforts that God will make to try to stop the person from being a threat to himself or herself. A behavioral disorder is a very serious problem when it is a consequence of the way that someone has failed God.

God is very offended when we engage in high-risk sexual behaviors. God has developed our sexuality so that we can work with a partner of the opposite gender to work with God to conceive a human life by sharing intimacy with our partner in front of God. God is flattered when he can present a new human life to a husband and wife. The conception and the birth of a new human life is the greatest event that can happen to God. Accepting a new human life and agreeing to develop that human life until he or she will become an adult is the greatest joy that we can offer to God. It is a commitment that gives God the greatest happiness that we could ever give him.

Sexually transmitted diseases happen when individuals hurt God by their sexual behaviors. Persons that abuse God by using their sexual capabilities for purposes other than the conception of human life in a way that involves numerous partners can deeply hurt and offend God. God does not want to hurt people with sexually transmitted diseases. However, God can only tolerate these behaviors to a certain extent before he will become violent.

God can make us feel pain if He detects that we have the willful intent to hurt ourselves and/or to hurt others. God can inflict severe pain for individual that proceed to devastate Humanity with senseless acts of violence and other crimes while having a complete indifference toward the feelings of God and the Holy Spirit.

God Chooses Our Destiny and Our Fate

God tries to develop a plan for all of us. He tries to have a vision of how we could eventually do for Him as part of Humanity. He wants us to perform in a profession that we would enjoy and that would give us satisfaction. God would want us to meet a destiny that would be fulfilling for us and would contribute to the development of Humanity.

God also chooses our Fate. God decides our Fate when a catastrophe makes it impossible to achieve our destiny. A person's Fate is a second plan that God has for us when we cannot meet our destiny. God tries hard to develop a secondary plan for us that will help us to serve Him and to serve Humanity in a way that we would find to be fulfilling.

God tries to give us the aptitude to achieve our His mission for us. God can give us special gifts and talents that we can use to perform the duties of the profession that He wants us to work in. God can help us to develop very important social skills, vocational skills, and leadership skills that can help us to succeed in a career.

God reveals His mission for us when we become young adults. We must decide how we will begin to work to achieve God's destiny for us when we are in middle school or in high school. God reveals His plan for us in a very private and quiet manner. God and the Holy Spirit give young adults the advice that they will need to choose the right school, the right training, and the right internships that will help them to achieve the goal that God has chosen for them.

God and the Holy Spirit are healing forces that work to help us to deal with our pain when others obstruct our efforts to achieve our destiny. God helps us to overcome the obstacles that others have placed in front of us. The Holy Spirit has special powers that help us to overcome our conflicts with others that frustrate our efforts to achieve the will of God. God and the Holy Spirit will work together and with other people in an individual's life to give that person the best chance to achieve God's plan for him or for her.

God and the Holy Spirit evaluate just how much we care about the livelihoods of our brothers and sisters throughout our communities and our schools. God evaluates the way that we work with our peers. God likes to see the "people person" in us that will try to have a friendly and powerful social attitude toward their peers and with other people such as teachers and members of the community. God and the Holy Spirit want to develop our young adults to be very sociable members of their student bodies and of their communities.

Our destiny has to do with showing a strong love for God and our desire to show love for God by being of service to all of our brothers and sisters of His Human Family. We all need to achieve God's will for us in order to face a lifetime of happiness and peace when we will deal with each other, with God, and with the Holy Spirit.

We must be courageous when we have to face our fate. We must have God and the Holy Spirit to fall back on when something goes wrong with God's plan for us. We must never lose faith in God when things go wrong. We must always look to God and the Holy Spirit for help in dealing with our problems and in trying to solve our problems.
